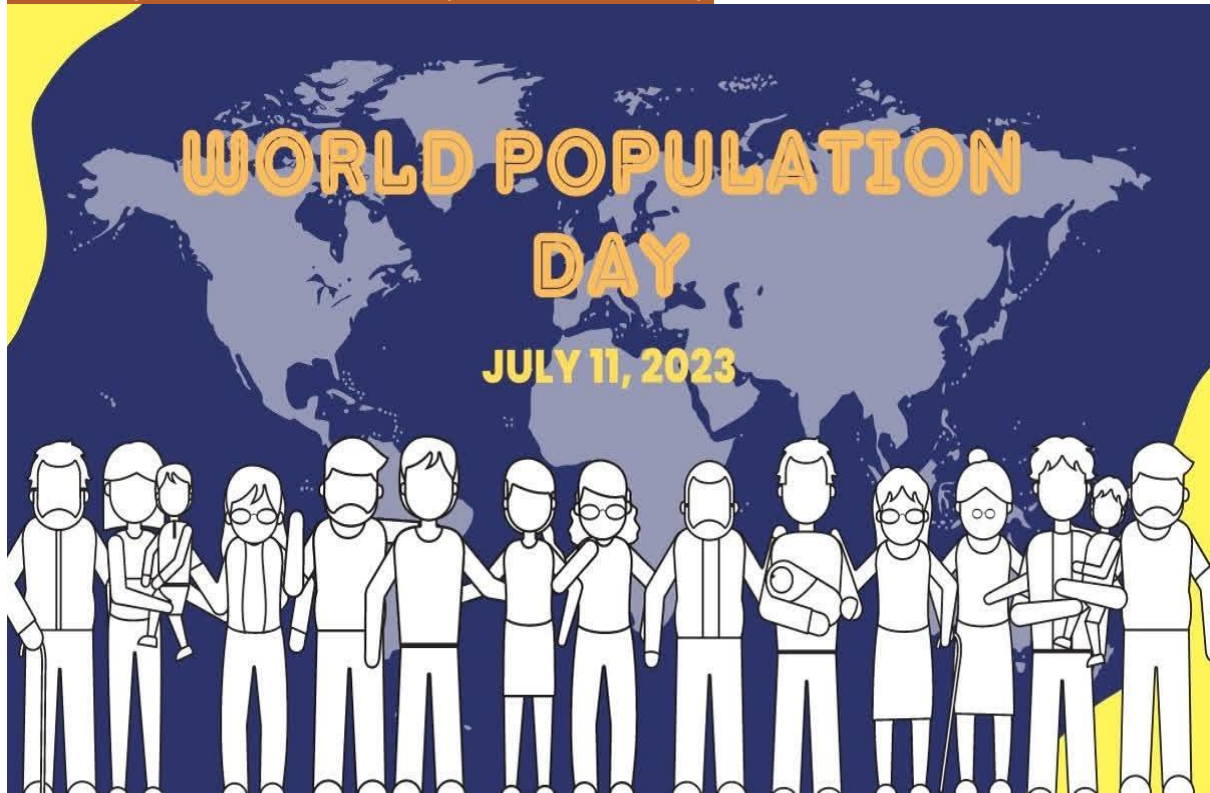

Gyanm Recommendations!

1. July 11: World Population Day



Supported by the UNO, the day seeks to bring attention to the urgency and importance of population related issues around the world. The day aims to highlight the difficulties created by overpopulation and raise awareness about how overpopulation may harm the ecosystem and progress of humanity.

According to the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNFPA), the theme for this year is “Unleashing the power of gender equality: Lifting the voices of women and girls to unlock our world’s infinite possibilities.”

2. India uplifts 41.5 cr out of poverty



The latest update of the global Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) covering 110 countries, was released on July 11 by the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and the Oxford Poverty and Human Development Initiative (OPHI) at the University of Oxford in Britain. India saw a remarkable reduction in poverty, with 415 million people exiting poverty within a span of just 15 years (2005/6–19/21). The report noted that deprivation in all indicators declined in India, and the poorest states and groups had the fastest absolute progress.

The UN said, 25 countries, including India, successfully halved their global Multidimensional Poverty Index (MPI) values within 15 years, showing that rapid progress is attainable. These 25 countries include Cambodia, China, Congo, Honduras, Indonesia, Morocco, Serbia, and Vietnam besides India.

3. Parth Salunkhe, 19-year-old archer from Satara, Maharashtra, became the first Indian male archer to win a gold in the recurve category at the Youth World Championships at Limerick, Ireland. The Indian team finished second in the medal tally with 6 gold, one silver and four bronze.



4. Rudransh Khandelwal, 19 year old para-shooter won the gold and created a new world record in the P4 mixed 50m pistol SH1 category at the ISSF World Shooting Cup in Osijek (Croatia).

5. Shavkat Mirziyoyev: Leader of the Liberal Democratic Party was re-elected as the President of Uzbekistan

6. Joint Indo-US hunt operation against drugs



Operation “Broader Sword”, a joint multi-agency operation carried out in June 2023 by the law enforcement agencies of the US and India, more than 500 shipments of “illicit and unapproved prescription drugs” were stopped from reaching US consumers. The operation targeted shipments of illicit, potentially dangerous, unapproved prescription drugs, combination medical devices, and synthetic drug precursors shipped through International Mail Facilities (IMF).
