Gyanm Recommendations!

1. The Asian Development Bank (ADB) approved a \$295-million loan for improving the infrastructure in Bihar. The project aims to upgrade approximately 265 km of state highways in Bihar, incorporating climate and disaster-resilient designs and road safety measures.



2. Asmita Dey (48kg), Unnati Sharma (63kg) and Arun Kumar (73kg) won the individual gold medals on July 23 in their respective categories at the Junior Asia Cup Judo Championship in Macau, China.

3. ISRO launches 7 Singapore satellites

ISRO successfully launched Singapore's DS-SAR satellite and six co-passenger payloads onboard its PSLV-C56 rocket on July 30 from Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh. DS-SAR (SAR-Synthetic Aperture Radar) is a Radar Imaging Earth Observation satellite. In addition to this, there were six co-passenger customer satellites also, all belonging to Singapore. All the satellites were placed into a 535 km high circular orbit.

4. Tiger population up by 6.1%, reaches 3,925



Latest data released by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change on the Global Tiger Day, July 29 puts the Tiger population estimates at 3,925. As per the detailed analysis of data done by the Wildlife Institute of India, from both camera-trapped and non-camera-trapped tiger presence areas, the upper limit of the tiger population is estimated to be 3,925 and the average number is 3,682 tigers, reflecting a commendable annual growth rate of 6.1 percent per annum.

Among states, Madhya Pradesh reported the largest number of Tigers at 785, followed by Karnataka at 563 and Uttarakhand at 560. Amongst Tiger Reserves, the largest number of Tigers, 260, are in Jim Corbett National Park, Uttarakhand.

Last year, during the celebration of 50 years of the Project Tiger at Mysuru, Prime Minister Narendra Modi had declared the minimum tiger population of 3,167, which is the population estimated from the camera-trapped area.
