1. September 5: Teachers' Day



The day marks the birth anniversary of Dr Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan. He was the first Vice President of India (1952–1962) and second President of India (1962–1967). A Bharat Ratna awardee, he was a teacher who turned out to be a renowned philosopher, scholar and politician. The day honours the contribution of teachers and educators for their significant role in shaping students' lives. The Ministry of Education presents the National Teachers Awards on this occasion every year.

Remember!! World Teachers' Day is observed on October 05.

2. September 5: International Day of Charity

The United Nations observes this day annually with the objective of sensitising and mobilising people, NGOs, all around the world to help others through voluntary philanthropic activities. The Day aims to alleviate the effects of humanitarian crises and to help in promoting education, housing, and child protection, and above all, removal of poverty. The date also commemorates the death anniversary of Saint Mother Teresa, the Nobel Peace Prize awardee of 1979.

3. Rajesh Nambiar: Elected as the chairman of the technology industry body Nasscom on Sep 04. He is the chairman and managing director of Cognizant India.



4. Malaviya Mission for Teachers' Training

On the occasion of Teachers' Day, Union Minister of Education, Dharmendra Pradhan, inaugurated the "Malaviya Mission: Teacher Training Programme" in New Delhi. The mission honours veteran educationist and founder of Banaras Hindu University, Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya, a Bharat Ratna awardee.

This initiative, conducted in collaboration between the University Grants Commission (UGC) and the Union Education Ministry, seeks to transform faculty capacity building and teacher preparation programs across the country's higher education institutions. It aims to train over 15 lakh teachers across the country.

5. Meta to train 5 lakh Indians in digi mktg.



Union Minister for Education and Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan launched a 3-year partnership “Education to Entrepreneurship: Empowering a generation of students, educators and entrepreneurs” between the Ministry and social media giant Meta on Sep 04 in New Delhi.

The groundbreaking programme aims to provide aspiring and established business owners with crucial digital marketing knowledge. It is expected to take digital skilling to the grassroots, covering over 5 lakh aspirants. It will enhance capacities of the talent pool, seamlessly connect students, youth, workforce and micro-entrepreneurs, with futuristic technologies and transform them into new-age problem solvers and entrepreneurs.

6. World's first counter- drone launched



For the first time in the country, a state-of-the-art autonomous anti-drone system, powered by artificial intelligence, has been developed by a Hyderabad based firm, Green Robotics. Named Indrajaal, this is said to be not just India's but the world's only wide area Counter-Unmanned Aircraft System (C-UAS), that can provide a comprehensive and integrated security mechanism against moving threats that cannot be tackled with static defence systems.

This state-of-the-art system is capable of providing protection from micro, mini, small, large, and extra-large drones, signalling a significant advancement in Indian defence technology. Its coverage spreads 360 degree and can cover wide areas up to 4,000 sq km.
