Gyanm Recommendations!

1. India receives first C-295 MW aircraft



The first C-295 MW transport aircraft was received on Sep 13 by the Chief of the Air Staff, Air Chief Marshal VR Choudhari from the Airbus company at Seville in Spain. India has contracted to acquire 56 Airbus C-295 aircraft to replace the Indian Air Force AVRO fleet.

Airbus will deliver the first 16 aircrafts in fly-away condition and remaining 40 aircrafts will be manufactured and assembled by Tata Advanced Systems in India as part of an industrial partnership between the two companies.

The C-295 aircraft is used for tactical transport of up to 71 troops or 50 paratroopers, and for conducting logistic operations to locations that are not accessible by heavier transport aircrafts.

The day commemorates the adoption of Hindi as the official language of India on this day in 1949. Hindi written in Devanagari script was adopted as the official language of India by the Constituent Assembly of India.

Hindi is one of the two official languages of the Union Government — the other being English. The language was adopted under Article 343 of the Indian Constitution.

Remember! World Hindi Day (Vishwa Hindi Diwas) is observed on January 10 to mark the anniversary of the first World Hindi Conference that took place in 1975 in Nagpur, Maharashtra.

4. e-Courts Mission Mode Project Phase -3

With a view to improve access to justice using technology, the Union Cabinet approved the e-Courts Mission Mode Project Phase -3 on Sep 13 as a Central Sector Scheme. It will be spread over a period of four years with a financial outlay of 7,210 crore rupees. The project aims to establish online and paperless courts in order to make the judicial system more convenient, economical, and transparent for the citizens.

Those who do not have access to technology, can access the judicial services from eSewa Kendras. 4,400 e-Sewa Kendras will be set up at all the court complexes for this purpose.

5. RBI guidelines for returning property papers



The Reserve Bank of India has asked all the financial institutions to ensure that after the full repayment and closure of personal loan accounts, concerned movable/immovable property documents should be released within 30 days of closure of loan account.

In case of delay in doing so, financial institutions shall compensate the borrower at the rate of ₹5,000 for each day of delay. These directions are applicable from December 01, 2023.

In case of loss/damage to original movable/immovable property documents, the financial institutions will be required to assist the borrower in obtaining duplicate/certified copies of the lost/damaged documents. An additional time of 30 days will be available to the financial institution to complete this procedure and the delayed period penalty will be calculated thereafter i.e. after a total period of 60 days.

6. NPCI launches OTG Ring



The NPCI has launched an 'OTG Ring', a wearable ring-like gadget for facilitating contactless payments. The ring has been developed in collaboration with fintech startup LivQuik. It will allow users to make payments to any Near Field Communication (NFC)-based device. It aims to replace plastic cards for making payments through various open-loop transit programs. This will enable users to seamlessly access and participate in a wide range of transit services, further enhancing the ring's utility and value.

1. A two day International Conference on Dam Safety was held on Sep 14-15 at Jaipur in Rajasthan. Professionals from across the nation and about fifteen countries participated in the conference.



2. Louisville, the largest city in Kentucky state of USA, has declared September 3 as Sanatana Dharma Day emphasising the significance of fostering peace, tolerance, and understanding within diverse communities.

3. The United Kingdom has committed to allocate \$2 billion to the Green Climate Fund (GCF). It is the world's largest fund of its kind, established within the framework of United Nations' climate change negotiations.

4. India and the United Kingdom jointly announced the launch of the Infrastructure Financing Bridge to work together to unlock substantial infrastructure investment opportunities in India.

5. With a view to provide an improved travel experience to its personnel and their families, the Indian Navy signed a MoU with Uber, a leading global cab aggregator service. 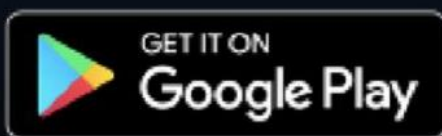
