Bulk deposit limit raised to 1 cr for RRBs

The RBI announced on Oct 26 that the bulk deposit limit for Regional Rural Banks (RRBs) has been increased from Rs 15 lakh to Rs 1 crore. The move is expected to provide a more level playing field for banks. Banks can offer varying interest rates on bulk deposits in line with their fund requirements.



The definition of "Bulk Deposit" varies among banks. The bulk deposit limit for scheduled commercial and small finance banks is Rs 2 crore and above.

Norway to fund 'Hunger Project'; in Uttarakhand



Norway has pledged its support to India's Hunger Project being run in Uttarakhand to improve food security and hunger issues in the region. Norway will provide ₹44.7 million for a period of three-years, until September 2026. The project aims to empower women leaders, enhance food security, and protect the environment, particularly in the ecologically sensitive region of Uttarakhand.
