

A. Metro Gold® Maple Acer campestre 'Panacek'

The Metro Gold® Maple is an upright, narrow oval cultivar that has a tighter shape than other species. It is an excellent street tree that has earned a reputation as a tough city tree. Medium growth rate.

#### B. Tamukeyama Japanese Maple

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Tamukeyama'

The Tamukeyama Japanese Maple is a red lace leaf Japanese maple. It has a rounded to broad shape with low branching. It does well in full sun to part shade.



Beauty and unique character paired with ease of culture make the Redpointe® Maple an easy addition to the fall landscape.

#### Here are a few things that we love about the Redpointe® Maple.

#### **Splendor and Poise**

Uniform growth throughout multiple seasons reduces pruning and maintenance requirements and also maintaining an attractive aesthetic. This tree holds a classic teardrop shape with natural branch angles and symmetrical canopy development. Leaves maintain a fresh, deep-green color throughout the summer, even throughout the heat. Smaller and pest tolerant leaves reliably deliver stunning, deep red colors in the fall.

Redpointe Maples at Garden Gate.

The Redpointe® Maple is tolerant of higher pH soils and will provide dazzling fall colors earlier than other trees. Many maples are grown in areas with a high soil pH, which often encourages leaf chlorosis, especially during the warmer summer months. This variety of North American adapted species has been improved to resist yellowing and chlorosis, as well as anthracnose, spider mites, and leafhoppers.

This adaptability to a variety of local climates and soil types is one of the strengths of this tree. It persistently insists on providing the earliest, brightest, and highest quality color that adds a wonderful aesthetic to any landscape.

#### **Ease of Culture**

Vigorous and symmetrical canopy growth keeps fresh all summer long. With a six-foot clearance from the ground at maturity, expect a total of 45 feet in height, spreading about 30 feet wide. Lower branches can be pruned to allow for higher clearance. This fast growing three should be pruned only after leaves have fully developed in the summer, and can live for over 80 years.

Colorful red branches and silvery bark add accents, especially at the emergence of eye-catching red flowers in the early spring. For vigorous growth, plant this tree in full sunlight as an accent or shade tree. One of the benefits of the Redpointe maple is its adaptability, which allows it to be successful in average to wet conditions, and even tolerating moderate standing water.

#### Made for the Urban Landscape

Shallow roots are adaptable to a variety of soil conditions, making the Redpointe maple a win for the urban landscape. Straight upright growth does not threaten to obstruct urban activities, and sturdy branches are attractive from all angles. Landscapers and homeowners can revel in the consistency and reliability in shape as well as low maintenance needs.

When spring leaves emerge for a dazzling display, trees contribute to the visual and physical aesthetics of the landscape. Female blossoms do not release pollen, which is a welcome relief for those who suffer from allergies. Paired with a high tolerance for urban pollution, this tree is a net positive for air quality.

#### D. Avondale Chinese Redbud

#### A. Narrow Yellow Alaskan Cedar

Chamaecyparis nootkatensis'Van den Akker'

The Narrow Alaskan yellow cedar is a pillar-like spire rising up in the garden with side branches that weep down and hug the main trunk. It is extremely useful for small gardens or tight spaces.

#### B. Slender Hinoki False Cypress

Chamaecyparis obtusa 'Gracilis'

The Slender Hinoki Cypress is an open-branched, narrow, upright growing evergreen tree. It has tiny, deep green needles with reddish new growth and bronze coloring in the winter.

#### C. Weeping Alaskan Cedar Blue

Chamaecyparis nootkatensis 'Glauca Pendula'

The Blue Weeping Alaskan Cedar is a tall narrow form with blue-green foliage and a graceful habit. Its pyramidal shape and weeping branches make it ideal for the landscape. It prefers full sun and good drainage.

#### D. Stricta Weeping Alaskan Cedar

The June Snow Dogwood (Cornus Controversa 'June Snow-JFS') is an incredible ornamental variety that quickly made it to our list of favorite trees this year when we started growing it for the first time. From a fast growth rate to its flowers, this tree is quite different than its Dogwood family members.

It is a fast growing tree. If you are familiar with Dogwoods, then you know that most trees in this family are not fast growers. In fact, I would go as far to say that 90% of Dogwood trees sold in nurseries are slow growing trees, especially Cornus florida and Cornus kousa varieties. So that is why this characteristic is so special. This tree is a fast-growing Dogwood and will reach its mature size of 30 feet in height and 40 feet in diameter in under 30 years. By the time it has left our farm it will have 5-7 years under its belt so you will be able to count on having a semi-mature tree 5 years after planting.

The June Snow has a unique growth shape. Another feature of this tree that really makes it special is its growth shape. The tree takes on a wide-spreading form and provides lots of shade while staying low enough to be in the medium category of size. This makes the tree a great fit in urban landscapes and locations where height can be an issue.



**The tree is hardy.** The June Snow Dogwood is categorized in Zone 5 and is popular in areas of hot summers and cold winters.

**June Snow's show off in the fall.** Although this is not entirely unique to Dogwoods, this is still a great feature of the tree. "Dark green summer foliage gives way to mottled fall tones of orange-yellow, red, purple and purple-red. Abundant clusters of blue-black, 1/4-inch fruits also create seasonal interest and attract birds to the garden."-JFS

We all love birds and it is great to have some trees in the landscape to naturally keep birds near and in our landscapes during the cloudy fall days. You never know when you might want to hear the singing out your window.

**The June Snow has amazing white flower clusters.** In May, this tree shows off its incredible flowers. The flowers of this tree are unlike traditional Cornus flowers in the fact that they show themselves off more as a cluster of small white flowers. Many Dogwood varieties have large white and pink flowers, but this tree has large, unique clusters of small star shaped flowers.

#### A. Aurora Dogwood

Cornus x 'Rutgan

The Aurora Dogwood has large, overlapping white flower blooms with a velvety texture that almost cover the foliage of this small tree in early spring. It is exceptionally disease and borer resistant.

#### B. June Snow™ Dogwood

Cornus controversa 'June Snow'-JFS

# C. Eddie's White Wonder Dogwood

### D. Cherokee Brave Dogwood Cornus florida

The Cherokee Brave Dogwood has giant deep pink blooms with white tips on the bloom. It is noted for its resistance to disease. Slow growth rate.

#### E. Stellar Pink Dogwood

Cornus x 'Rutgan'

The secret is out, Paul's Scarlet Hawthorn is this year's darling. Otherwise known as Crataegus laevigata 'Pauls Scarlet', our new favorite tree delivers rosy blooms and seasonally adorable ornamental fruit. Dark pink blossoms resembling tiny roses burst in a dazzling display throughout the spring.

Paul's Scarlet Hawthorn is the showiest hawthorn, and it's hard not to fall in love. Miniature rose clusters delicately perch on branches like nature's jewels. Cherry red fruits are soon to follow, persisting into the winter season, even after leaves have long flown the coop.

#### Miniature is the Perfect Size

With a spread of 15-20 feet and topping out in height at 25 feet, Pauls Scarlet Hawthorn is well suited to livening up the party as a wall of color in the backyard or brightening up the front as a single accent. Miniature flowers are fragrant, and the overall small size allows for easy maintenance.

Minimal pruning requirements are easy to perform on their low, dense branches, making this reliable talking piece a breeze to maintain. Leaves are quick to drop in the fall, especially in areas with cooler temperatures. Like a curtain dropping to reveal the star of the show, lobed and glossy leaves make way for festive, deep red fruits.

Adaptable and Easy

This tree is tolerant of a wide range of soil and climate conditions, so there is really no excuse not to squeeze in at least one Paul's Scarlet Hawthorn. While well-drained soils are

best, and this highly adaptable tree thrives in humid conditions as well as semi-arid areas.

Plant Paul's Scarlet Hawthorn at any time of the year, and prune any time after flowering in the summer or autumn to maintain the desired shape. Both sunny and partial shade conditions allow for vigorous growth, with most exciting developments occurring in the spring and autumn. Achieve true curbside appeal by trimming lower branches to heighten canopy-starting point and allow for traffic underneath.

#### A Jewel in the Rough

Shiny green foliage provides the perfect backdrop for cute and plentiful miniature roses. A deer-resistant trunk brings these adorable delights up to eye level while allowing for bird-friendly visitation. As a close relative to more commonly known roses, some trees have thorns, so keep this in mind when selecting the tree that best fits its function.

Some disease susceptibility in certain climates may cause leaves to drop earlier than unaffected trees, but caretakers can easily prune back affected branches. Dense hedgerows of Pauls Scarlet Hawthorn are common in the UK, so prune to fit any border for a more European feel. However, these trees do mature in a more rounded form, so keeping an attractive shape is still easy when pruning efforts fall by the wayside.

# A. Paul's Scarlet Hawthorn

Paul's Scarlet Hawthorn is a dense oval tree with small, green, deeply lobed foliage. It produces a double flower that is a beautiful scarlet to rose.




