Experience the opulence of the 2021 Brady Vineyard Petite Sirah — a rich, deep crimson wine. Notes of blackberry, black pepper, roasted vanilla, and spice create an aromatic delight. Indulge in its bramble flavors, luxurious texture, and gentle acidity. A hint of velvety oak extends the finish. Perfectly paired with smoked or roasted meats, sharp cheeses, and rich, flavorful sauces.

Vineyard

Nestled at the ideal crossroads for exceptional viticulture, the Brady Vineyard enjoys a prime location. Positioned inland enough to bask in daily warmth, yet near the Pacific Ocean benefiting from refreshing nightly breezes. The vines thrive in rocky soils overlooking the Estrella River, extracting nutrients and water. These factors harmonize, nurturing fully-ripened grapes perfect for crafting bold and robust Paso Robles wines.

Winemaker's Notes

We harvest when fruit flavors peak, avoiding any shriveling. The crushed fruit undergoes fermentation in stainless tanks with RX-60, a yeast strain enhancing Rhone varieties. Employing a classic hand pump-over technique maximizes color and flavor extraction. Post-pressing, the wine undergoes malolactic fermentation in oak barrels, maturing for 18 months.
