A community of +29K international self-identified women living in Berlin




We've noticed a problem...



In a big and international city, such as Berlin, there's a lack of space for self identified women to talk about their issues and questions.



Normally, the first place they look for help is inside online forums. But unfortunately in those spaces they get harassed by creeps and trolls.



Another issue those women face is missing a close circle of friends.
And after the lockdown and during these Corona times, they are feeling more lonely and craving even more for a sense of community.

A supportive community International Women in Berlin


IWB provides a **safe space** where women can talk about their lives and ask for any kind of help – from dating, German courses to doctors and bureaucracy issues in Berlin.

IWB also provides online and offline spaces, where members can meet and lift each other up, so they don't feel alone in Berlin.





We help international women to navigate their lives better in Berlin. From dealing with German bureaucracy, to connecting to new people and making new friends. Online and offline.

• Empathetic:

Most members experienced trolls and aggressive language in other groups. That's not acceptable in our group and the members really appreciate that.

How we support our community


• Education & Information:


• Connecting & Networking:

How we support our community


Sharing Stories & Amplifying Voices:

We also share helpful resources such as lists or recommended doctors, how to make free STI tests, mental health support, etc.





How we support our community

• Organising and curating the best content:





Who the IWB members are

- Over 100 nationalities
- Very hyper-local group, with almost all members living in Berlin or trying to move to Berlin.
- The majority of members are in between 25 and 34 years old.
- They are mostly students, interns and full-time employees.



Who the IWB members are

- People who join the group are interested in having a good life in Berlin. 30 to 50 new women request to join the group, everyday.
- They look for jobs, housing and bureaucracy tips. But also they want to know about fun things to do in Berlin, dating and even self esteem boost and mental health support.
- The growth of the group is pretty steady and most members invite their friends to join the group. That happens because they trust the group as a helpful resource.
- We have a monthly rate of above 20k active members and 6,306 IG followers (we started our IG on March 2021)
- Daily engagement in between +10k and +13k and a 3.26% engagement rate on Instagram.





Who the IWB members are

Here are 3 personas that exemplifies most of the members inside the IWB community



Maria, 25

From Latin America, a newcomer who just started her internship. Also just adopted a new dog and is searching for a new WG. She is struggling with learning German and is dealing with some visa issues. She wants to make new friends in Berlin and travel around Europe.

Hello, my name is Bruna!

I'm a Brazilian designer who came to Berlin a couple of years ago to start a new life in a city where we can find all kinds of people and possibilities to get what you want in life.

Or that's what I thought.

Yes, Berlin can be an amazing city to fulfill your dreams. But that can be extremely hard when you don't know anybody in the city. It's pretty hard to make friends and network in a new city. And as a woman, sometimes you don't feel that safe to go alone to some places and just talk to strangers.

I felt that. And all the women in this city who I talked to went through that kind of experience as well. Based on that, I created a Facebook Group in 2017 to connect self-identified women in Berlin.

During the last years, I've seen a lot of sisterhood and women empowerment inside the group. I've seen members inviting their friends to our community, witnessed new friendships being built, women getting jobs and housing from contacts they made inside IWB, getting their visa status sorted out and a lot of people being nice and helping each other.





With the growth of the community, I heard the member's feedback and what would help them to achieve success in Berlin. We started organising events and workshops. We started sharing info about Berlin and Germany, and much more.

The more people would join us, the more work we had to deal with. That's why IWB isn't only a FB group anymore, but a whole project to support a community in various ways.

To keep helping our community of immigrant women, some members are voluntarily helping with some tasks related to the IWB project. Which is amazing, but unfortunately not enough.

That's why IWB is searching for partners and sponsors that could help our project to grow and make much more impact in the lives of women living in Berlin.


Support your local women gang
