Letter to SRA Members

September 10, 2015

Dear SRA Members.

The beginning was long ago, but yet it was just yesterday that we retired. It seems the days go by much faster now and some never have enough time to get it all done. Life is busy, fulfilling, and very exciting!

The SRA began in 1998 because some very caring folks needed to address the fear and uncertainty brought on by a new and unknown entity by the name of SBC. Retirees at that time had no knowledge of what would happen to them under a "proposed merger". God bless them for asking the questions that would ultimately be addressed by the DPUC to the company. And from that, came the transformation of a friendly coffee group into a not-for-profit corporation that was chartered by the State of CT. Your support and involvement has enabled those accomplishments to grow into what the SRA is today.

Over the years the SRA has assisted other SBC/AT&T retiree groups across the country to form, to be recognized by the company, and to grow their memberships. We have participated in national forums, testified before the legislature, advocated for revisions in laws, assisted in securing an understanding of our earned benefits, proposed and gained shareholder support on corporate matters, and protected the pension plan during underfunded years. And of course, the most important function was to help our members and their family members in times of need.

For the SRA Board of Directors over the years, there was no more rewarding job than that of assisting a retiree who could not find a telephone number or provide answers about a new

Frank known to many as fair, level headed, a pioneer of equal pay, job evaluation expert, forward thinker, and a true true friend of many passed away after a very brief battle with cancer on July 28th. He is survived by his wife Laurel (also a retiree) along with several children and grandkids. Our deepest sympathy to them.
- » The SRA extends our thanks to Judy Kleist who has taken on new projects which have made it difficult for her to continue her commitment to her fellow retirees. Many thanks Judy.
- published the letter we published the letter we sent to the President of Frontier CT. regarding vacation shut offs and retirees not having the ability to change plans without loss of discounts. Well, vacation shutoffs are back for the CT consumer per a notice from Frontier. However they have yet to address the loss of discounts if a plan is changed even to upgrade... So be careful!!!
- » AT&T Mobility has instituted paperless billing for all employees and retirees. When first announced

- earlier this year they would no longer accept a credit or debit card as payment. That position has been retracted!!! You can pay with a credit card or debit card effective immediately. And you must go on line to see your bill or call 611 from your cell phone for payment info as paper bills will no longer be sent.
- From SRA Board Member Harry Green we have learned about SILVER SNEAKERS. The program called 'Health Ways in the Silver Sneakers Program'. Harry thought it was just for folks over a certain age. Wrong! Now some of you might be aware of it, but in case you are not, here is all you have to do: call 866 584-7389, hit the prompt #1. Give your name, coverage plan, (Medicare, private plan etc.) and they look it up to determine if you are eligible. They give you a member number, tell you if your plan covers it, and what participating gyms in your area that you can go for free. It is a benefit covered in some insurance plans which may be a benefit you may not have exercised! (no pun intended!)
- » We will begin the planning of our Florida meetings for 2016 after the 2015

- holidays. Notices of all the locations will be mailed to only those members who have a FL address or provide the SRA with their FL. winter addresses. If you are interested in attending please be sure we know where to send the notice.
- » You may have noticed we have a new mailing address. We no longer will be using a post office box due to logistics and the changes announced in this newsletter.

restores creditor protections to retirees who lost those protections in pension derisking transfers. Without this protection, after a pension de-risking transfer, creditors could garnish annuity payments, even those designed for retirement. Although this has no impact on AT&T retirees it did impact folks who worked for Bell Atlantic and Bell Tel who reside in CT. Bell Tel Retiree Assoc. has been spearheading this effort due to pension plans being turned over to insurance type industries.

- » September 2, 2015, Verizon released the following: "The Federal Communications Commission today approved the proposed \$10.54 billion sale of Verizon's local wireline network assets and operations in California, Florida and Texas, to Frontier Communications (FTR)."
- » Also noted, "The proposed sale of Verizon's wireline properties in California, Florida, and Texas, to Frontier Communications was announced on February 5, 2015. The companies anticipate completion of the transaction by the end of the first quarter of 2016."
- » On July 9, the Treasury Department and the Internal Revenue Service announced

that it will amend its ERISA regulations to no longer allow sponsors of defined benefit pension plans to offer lump sum payments to replace pension annuity payments to pension plan participants who are in "pay status" (already receiving a monthly pension check). The policy is effective July 9, 2015. This IRS Notice does not apply to retirees or former employees not yet collecting a pension. It has been permissible for companies to offer lump sums to active employees and those who have retired but are not yet eligible for vested benefit payments. The amendment does

not prevent pension plan sponsors from taking derisking action through the purchase of a third party annuity (i.e. an insurance company) to replace a defined benefit pension plan. Nor does the amended regulation prevent a pension plan sponsor from doing a voluntary pension plan termination through a voluntary lump sum offer and/or annuity purchase. Pension plan sponsors that have already received Treasury/IRS approval to offer a voluntary lump sum pension buyout—such as Alcatel-Lucent's recent announcement—are allowed to go forward.

2016 AT&T BENEFIT HIGHLIGHTS/CHANGES

- AT&T will fund HRA's at the same dollar levels as in 2015
- Any remaining money from 2015 HRA's will be carried over to 2016
- Enrollment for those involved in the AON Exchange will be from 10/15/15 through 12/7/15.
- Enrollment dates for those covered under the AT&T Medical Plans (under age 65) are Oct 6 -17 for management retirees and for union retirees it is from Oct 20th through the 31st.
- IF you or your dependent will be age 65 by February 1, 2016 you will move to the AON Health Exchange
- Plans and pricing offered by AARP (medical, dental vision) will not be on AON web site, but is available via the AON representatives. (AARP stipulations)
- Added benefit options for vision and dental not available through AON last year will be available for 2016 through AON (but not the AT&T plan coverage level)
- New for 2016 for those who
 do not use healthcare or script
 through AON you will be able
 to have an HRA just for dental
 and vision and amounts will
 be for that coverage only of
 \$300 for retiree and \$200 for
 dependent.
- New if you are the retiree and under the AT&T Medical Plan (under age 65) and your partner /spouse work at any

- employer who offers healthcare coverage and the dependent does not use their own medical plan from that employer there will be a "surcharge" of \$100 per month to keep them on the AT&T plan, plus the normal premium and out of pocket costs.
- If not making any changes in 2016 you have to do nothing... just continue to pay your premiums.
- If making changes (those on Medicare) that can be done during open enrollment from 10/15/through 12/7 and you can make an appointment by calling AON reps OR on line.
- Changing plans under the AON Exchange may require participants to answer health questions. (Requirement by some states)
- AT&T Medical, Drug and Dental Plans will have 3 tiers for coverage: Bronze, Silver and Gold. Each will have differentiated deductibles and costs. for deductibles and out of pocket costs
- AT&T Vision plan will move to calendar year schedule not date of service schedule.
- The total amount for the HRA does not increase if choosing vision or dental in addition to medical and or scripts. The total for a retiree is \$2700 and for an eligible dependent is \$1500.

health care plan, or vendor, or helping a widow understand the life insurance provisions. And let's not forget concession questions - especially when changes came along on products, services or the impact of yet another buyout!

Today we reflect on so many that are not able to be with us, whether they are moving to be closer to family members, death, illness, caring for their loved ones or just off on a vacation. Your SRA board has also been reflecting on the future of our organization. The board members themselves have had life events that have changed for them, or have decided to travel more, or take on a new vocation to help others. Additionally, our membership has been dwindling due to the passing of many of the original founding members, newer retirees remaining in the work force in other capacities, and simply a lack of interest in joining due to a variety of reasons.

For all of these reasons, as well as the sale of AT&T East Residential to Frontier, the SRA Board of Directors took a hard look at our future over the last year. Due to that sale there will no future retirees from SNET, SBC, or AT&T going forward. And the current membership is stagnating. We had discussed ending the SRA in the past, and had said we still felt we have more to care for. We are glad we did stick around, especially to help so many through the complicated conversion of the healthcare plan last year. AND we plan to stick around a little longer with a few changes going forward.

The SRA Board has voted unanimously to:

- 1. Waive all future dues collection for all current paid members.
- 2. New members will be admitted with a onetime dues payment of \$15.
- 3. Current assets of the SRA will be used to continue to publish the SRA Newsletter, maintain the SRA website and database, mail news bulletins as needed and conduct annual meetings in Connecticut and Florida (we will continue to subsidize the meeting costs as we do today). All these activities will continue to be supported until all SRA assets are diminished.
- 4. The SRA Board will continue as advocates for its members and their dependents as needed.
- 5. The SRA Executive Board will continue in its role as the deciding members of the organization as outlined in the current bylaws.

**** (Looking at our current assets and expenses we anticipate approximately another 2 1/2 to 3 years of activities depending on inflation and unforeseen issues)

























