2021 Impact

In 2021, Shai Fund impacted over
75,400 people in **8 countries**.

Highlights

55,233

Vulnerable and displaced people received food, medicine, and/or hygiene kits

12,077

At-risk people were evacuated and/or assisted in safe houses

5,666

Persecuted religious minorities were provided economic opportunities

2,500

Impoverished children and their families received food and Christmas gifts

In 2021, Shai Fund evacuated **12,000** at-risk people from Afghanistan and distributed **thousands** of essential supplies during crises.



Livelihoods & Education

- **5,666** persecuted minorities received vocational training or funding to launch their own businesses in Egypt, Syria, and Iraq
- **240** minorities received educational, cultural, and integration support in Israel and Palestinian Territories



Rescue & Medical Care

- **12,000** female lawyers and judges, at-risk women, and religious minority families were evacuated from Afghanistan
- **1,040** people affected by Covid and the Beirut blast received medicine in Lebanon



Food, Shelter & Clean Water

- **77** Afghan refugees were assisted in safe houses in Pakistan and resettled to Brazil
- **650** families received urgent food and medical aid inside Afghanistan



Crisis & Disaster Response

- **41,350** internally displaced people received support following attacks in Mozambique
- **10,803** vulnerable people living in Algerian refugee camps received hygiene kits



Looking Ahead:

- **Ukraine:** Equip civilians to provide life-saving medical assistance, and evacuate people under siege. Disrupt trafficking networks and collect criminal evidence for prosecuting traffickers.
- **Afghanistan:** Evacuate 500 religious minorities, including women at risk of being trafficked. Resettle 5,000 refugees.
- **Iraq & Syria:** Fund a medical clinic in Syria and provide livelihoods for religious minorities impoverished by war.
