## Helicopter Scenic Flight

The word blyde, loosely translated from Afrikaans to English, literally means 'joy'. Along the way, Jana, an accredited field guide, will share information with you about ongoing conservation initiatives and how the inhabitants of the diverse patchwork quilt beneath you fit together.

As you rise above the varied biomes, spotting animals roaming free below you, we are sure you will experience joy in its purest form. To flit over the basking fruit orchards and witness the elevation of the mighty Drakensberg Mountains before zooming headlong into the breathtaking canyon is a life-changing experience. The flight on the way back provides a heart-stopping moment, as the mountain (highveld) seems to drop out from underneath you, giving way to a jaw-droppingly beautiful panorama. Awestruck, you are rewarded with lesser-seen views of the Lowveld as far as the eye can see. Amazing!

The hour-long Blyde River Canyon helicopter flip is an exhilarating journey from the Lowveld bush to one of the largest canyons on Earth. The helicopter enters the spectacular canyon over the Blyde dam and joins the rare Cape Vultures in their airspace. This activity is truly a sensory overload and an unforgettable experience.
