Use N4 – eMalahleni (Witbank) Freeway, passing eMalahleni (Witbank), through the tollgate, passing Middelburg and on to eMakhazeni (Belfast). - At eMakhazeni (Belfast) follow the R540 to Dullstroom and Mashishing (Lydenburg). - At Mashishing (Lydenburg) follow the R36 through to Origstad and on the Abel Erasmus Pass through the J.G. Strydom tunnel to Hoedspruit.

Travel through Hoedspruit Town, crossing over a **railway bridge** and you will come the last 4 way-stop. Phalaborwa left & White River right. **Turn right** onto the R40. Once passing through the next 4-way stop, take the **first left hand** turn after leaving town, indicating **Timbavati / Eastgate Airport**.

When turning left onto the Eastgate Airport/Timbavati Road, you will see a control gate. You might be required to sign in but will not need to pay anything.

Carry on until you reach the control gate into the Timbavati (Enkhulu Gate) – 17km.

Proceed through Enkhulu Gate – you will be required to sign in but will not need to pay anything. Once you are through this gate, turn **immediately left** and travel back on to the dirt road. This dirt road will take you to Incheni Gate. There are signs from Incheni Gate to **Last Word Kitara**.

From Enkhulu Gate to Incheni Gate is 4km. The gate fee into the reserve is R300 cash per vehicle.

Once through Incheni Gate, carry straight on the main dirt road for approx 20 min. You will see a large Vodacom cell phone tower on your right-hand side. Approx 50 meters after the tower you will see a turn to your left indicating Dundee West – take that left-hand turn. From Incheni Gate to the turn-off is 12.9km.

After turning left, you will travel for a further 10-15 min, crossing over a concrete causeway over the Klaserie River. After 4.9km, you will come to a staggered 4-way intersection with a sign indicating Dundee West. **Turn right** at this intersection (the road well-travelled will take you right).

Continue straight along that road. After 6.1km (approx. 25 min) you will pass a **trig beacon on your left-hand side** and a sign that says Dundee straight. After 3.3km, you will then see that this road naturally bends sharply to the right (with a No Entry sign) – **go right** (well-travelled road).

Once you have taken the right-hand bend, continue for 5.2km to the Nzumba Lodge head-on t-junction. After approx \
10 min from this bend, you will reach a sign that says Zeekooigat left and Kitara/Nzumba/Ivory Wilderness straight.

Continue straight on that road – you will pass through 2 small river lines. At the top of the hill after the 2nd drainage line, the road naturally bends to the left (and a stone marker that says Kitara/Nzumba/Ivor Wilderness). Continue on this road, you will come to a gravel airstrip. Cross over the airstrip, the road will take you around the side of Nzumba Lodge on the left (do not turn off until you reach a head-on t-junction).

Once you reach the head-on t-junction, **turn right** (turning left will take you to Nzumba). Continue on this road for 6.3km – approx. 20 min, after 10 min you will start winding down a hill, go through a little causeway and just after that Ivory Wilderness will be on your right follow **Last Word Kitara** signs.

Carry on past & go through a big dip and 200m down the road you will arrive at the Last Word Kitara.
