

A Global Talent Solutions Company Obtains Quality Assurance of its Contractual Review Process

The Problem

Our client was part of a +\$10 billion global talent solutions (resource augmentation) group. The group had offshored its contract review function to a team in India. This had led to significant cost reductions. However, the General Counsel was concerned that the approach taken by the team in India was ad hoc and prone to inconsistency. In addition, there was no systematic way of ensuring contracts the team prepared were of a consistent quality.

The Solution

The team at ContractProbe worked with the team in India to obtain data on the types of contracts they most frequently reviewed and the issues they sought to identify. Many of those contracts were already covered by ContractProbe's existing product suite. However, some of the issues were not treated in the manner that was most helpful to the contract reviewers. In addition, the manner in which the results were presented did not suit the working style of some of the firm's lawyers.

Over a three month period we worked with the team in India and the General Counsel to ensure ContractProbe operated in a way that was most useful to the team. In addition, we tailored the tool so that the issues of most concern in the contract review process were identified by the technology and reported on.
