




Washington State Conservation Commission meeting July 15, 2021 Jean Fike –Cultural Resources Coordinator

EO21-02 replaced EO 05-05 April 7, 2021

- Very similar- with a few differences
 - New documentation requirement
 - Certain property acquisitions included



- Also requested by DAHP
 - Practice lists update
 - 5 year revisit



What is staying the same?



- WSCC is responsible for compliance
- Districts must attest
- Two practice lists
- Need to allow time
- Reimbursement for most expenses




Also not new

- RCW 27.53 prohibits knowingly disturbing or removing archeological resources on public or private property
- An unanticipated discovery plan (UDP) strongly recommended
- Don't wait steady as she goes
- Help and training are available. Call anytime!

What would change?

- Policy language
- Documentation to DAHP
- Practice lists to be updated
- Revisit every 5 years
- Property acquisition projects culminating in soil-disturbing construction activities would now be subject to cultural resources review
- Forms etc. are being updated


