#### Beaver Valley Farms FPLA Authorization

Motion by Commissioner Longrie for the Conservation Commission to accept the FPLA Work Group's recommendation regarding Jefferson Land Trust's Beaver Valley Farm amendment request. The Conservation Commission approves up to \$101,400 in FPLA funding to add the 8.5-acre parcel, bringing the total area to be protected to 47.5 acres. Seconded by Commissioner Beale. Motion carried.

#### Centralia 43 Funding Authorization

Motion by Commissioner Longrie for the Conservation Commission to accept the FPLA Work Group's recommendation regarding Washington Farmland Trust's Centralia 43 application. The Conservation Commission approves up to \$550,000 in FPLA funding for the acquisition of an agricultural conservation easement on the Centralia 43 property by Washington Farmland Trust. The Conservation Commission authorizes its Executive Director to sign the conservation easement as a third-party beneficiary. Seconded by Commissioner Mumford. Motion carried.
