- c) must not be an employee of MEA, nor an employee, officer, or director of any union currently acting as a bargaining agent for the Association employees;
- d) must not currently be a complainant in an administrative proceeding or a plaintiff in any litigation filed in a state or federal trial court in which either MEA, one or more of its employees, or one or more of its members of the Board of Directors of the Association are an adverse party, and where the subject matter of the litigation arises out of or otherwise concerns the affairs of the Association; or lives in the same household with any such person.
