

Jerome (Jerry) Gordon Laumann passed away Sunday, September 13, 2020 surrounded by his family.

Jerry was born September 11, 1941 in Grand Rapids, Minnesota to Gordon and Isabelle Laumann. He grew up in Deer River, Minnesota enjoying fishing and hunting in the "Land of 10,000 Lakes".
