

Reviewing the Posters Game

This game is a fun way of reviewing the five posters that the groups analyzed during the jigsaw activity.

a. **Online version**

If students have computers, the game can be played on [Socrative](#).

b. **Offline version**

Play the game as a "Four Corner Activity."

Each corner of the room is marked "A," "B," "C," and "D."

Students stand in the appropriate corner representing the answer for each question.

When asking the question, project the image of the relevant poster, or provide printed posters to the students.
