



# **SYNOPSIS**

The action takes place in Lubbock (Texas), Clovis (New Mexico), New York and Clear Lake (Iowa), between January 1956 and February 1959.

With the support of local radio DJ, Hipockets Duncan, Buddy and his two friends form a Country & Western band — Buddy Holly & the Crickets — and begin to carve out a career in music. After a difficult start at Decca Records in Nashville, they sign a contract with up-and-coming, innovative record producer Norman Petty. Within hours, Buddy Holly & the Crickets start to churn out hits from the recording studio built in Norman's backyard, among them *That'll Be The Day*, which will rocket up the charts to number one in a matter of weeks. Buddy Holly & the Crickets are suddenly the hottest act in the country and out on national tour.

Whilst recording in New York, Buddy proposes to Maria Elena Santiago, the Puerto Rican receptionist of his music publisher after a courtship of all of five hours! Newly married and ambitious, he shifts focus to New York and a rift develops between him and the Crickets. After a declaration of home truths during a recording session, the band splits and Buddy unexpectedly finds himself having to pursue a solo career.

Buddy joins "The Winter Dance Party" of 1959, a bus tour through the Midwest quenching the teenage thirst for the "new music called Rock 'n' Roll." The tour is hard work, the weather conditions appalling and the performers are alternating between sleeping in the luggage racks and dropping into hospitals to be treated for frostbite.

Our story ends on February 3rd, 1959, after a rocking concert with the "Big Bopper" J.P. Richardson and Ritchie Valens at the Surf Ballroom in Clear Lake, Iowa. Buddy makes the fateful decision to break his promise to his pregnant wife not to fly, as he and the other two headliners board a small plane and take off into the night destined for their next show. During a snow storm, in the dead of night, the plane crashes and spares no survivors.

The tragedy shocked the world, snatching the lives of three of the world's most dynamic musical talents — Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens and the Big Bopper. Buddy Holly's brief life is immortalized in this dynamic and heart-rending stage show. It's a celebration of the man, his music and life, that catches that unique mixture of innocence, determination, humor and charm that was Buddy Holly.

...and the rest will just be Rock 'n' Roll.

#### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

Whether you are a superfan of Buddy Holly or have never heard of him, there is no denying his impact and legacy on the music world. Charles Hardin Holley, more commonly known as Buddy Holly, is often referenced as the father of rock n' roll. He was an innovator and pioneer, being one of the first performers to write and perform his own material. He also created the prototype of the rock band lineup — guitars, base, drums and vocals — which is now the lineup for every rock band that was and ever will be. The Beatles, the Rolling Stones, Bob Dylan, Elton John, Bruce Springsteen and many others credit Buddy as their inspiration. He blazed a path for so many musicians in style from how they played to feeling free to wear glasses on stage. His music was ahead of his time.

When directing a show that is a biography of a career and life, you can't help but jump into the rabbit hole of all the articles, documentaries, books, and movies searching for the clues to honor the authenticity of the characters and events portrayed. However, we view this particular story through the lens and memory of his friend and manager, Hipockets Duncan. This got me thinking about what exactly is a memory and what details are included or left out or forgotten? Some memories are painted with the vivid detail of a photograph and others are scattered, blurry and generalized puzzle pieces that sometimes feel cliche and incomplete as we put them together. Buddy's story has been recalled, retold, pieced together and immortalized in so many forms with varying degrees of authenticity. But there is no denying his music and his legacy. Today, I invite you to let the music transport you to a different time as you discover Buddy's music for the 1st or 10,000th time and allow the music to do what Buddy's music did best- unite and inspire.




