## **CAVALIER DAY** for K-12 families

**Thursday, July 21, 2022/Roncalli High School**  
**Open from 7-9am 11am-1pm 4-6pm**

At Cavalier Day you will do some or all of the following:

1. SIGN TUITION AGREEMENT
2. PAY 1st Month TUITION or sign authorization for automatic withdrawal of tuition. You will sign off on existing account or submit a new form. Please have your financial institution information handy.
3. PAY FEES. You have until the middle of Sept. to pay the extra fees.
4. Meet representatives from the parent organization PTO and other staff members.
5. SIGN UP FOR OST afterschool care, Wednesday early dismissal care and get your child's lunch account set up.

**Is attendance at Cavalier Day required?** This day is not required although it allows our families to make some valuable connections and see or meet other parents in the school system. Cavalier Day is for all families in the system.

## **OPENING DAY OF SCHOOL**

**Wednesday, August 24, 2022**

Kindergarten students will start the first two days of school on a split schedule. Families will receive a letter stating which day their student should attend. All other students are to report at the regular start time for a full day of classes.

All Roncalli Schools operate with a closed noon hour. Families are asked to have their children at school just prior to the start of classes.

## ***WEDNESDAY EARLY DISMISSAL***

ALL K-12 students are dismissed at 1:00 P.M. every Wednesday during the school year to allow staff to attend Professional Development.

Every Wednesday, the OST program will offer child care for K-6th grade from 1:00-3:20 at NO CHARGE to families who need their child/ren to stay until the regular end of the day. If you need your child to stay, **YOU MUST FILL OUT** a registration form in advance so we can adequately staff the program. FULL-TIME Preschool Families: Your child/ren can attend from 7:30-6:00 every day school is in session. It is your choice to pick up your child at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesdays or leave them for the remainder of the day.

## SCHOOL MEALS

The Aberdeen Catholic School System (ACSS) serves nutritious meals each day classes are in session for Pre-school -12th grade. The cost of the school meals are listed to the left.

### The following Lunch Policy will be enforced.

If a student's lunch account is overdrawn by \$15 or more, the student will be allowed to purchase a reimbursable meal, BUT WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to purchase extra entrée, milk or al a carte item until the account is paid.

If a student's account is overdrawn by \$100, that student will be informed and will be required to bring a sack lunch until the account is paid. Parents will be notified of an overdue amount via email and then by letter.

## MYSCHOOLBUCKS.COM

**You will not be required** to make payments on the website, but you will have total access to a record of your students spending and eating habits. You can make payments on your account at the ACSS business office at RHS or on the myschoolbucks website.

## ***OUT OF SCHOOL TIME SERVICES***

The OST program is accepting registrations for the 2022-2023 school year. Our program is open to all Kindergarten-6th grade students from 3:20 p.m.-6:00 p.m. every school day in session. The OST program provides a healthy snack daily, outside activities and games, crafts, adventures, and more! On some no school days, care will be offered dependent upon staffing availability and enrollment numbers.

\$10.00 per day (over 1 hour)

\$7.00 per day (1 hour or less)

Drop in rate: \$13/ day

No school day care: \$34/day

3rd grade- 6th grade: located at Roncalli Elementary School (501 3rd Ave SE)

## **IMMUNIZATION FOR 6TH GRADE & TRANSFER STUDENTS**

South Dakota Department of Health administrative rules now require both the Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) and MCV4 (Meningococcal ACYW) vaccines for 6th grade students (beginning with the 2016-17 school year). The requirements apply only for 6th grade entry and transfer students in 6th-12th grade.

If a child is 10 years old when entering the 6th grade, they have 45 days after their 11th birthday to be vaccinated. Reference the links below to get more details and answer questions.

- Parents/guardians who identify a security problem with the Parent Portal must notify the Aberdeen Catholic School System Technology Office immediately.
- Parents/guardians who are identified as a security risk to the Parent Portal or any other Aberdeen Catholic School System computers or network will be denied access to the Parent Portal.

Any parent who, by court order, has been deprived of visitation rights or of access to school records, shall not be permitted computer access to the school records.
