
Now is the time to put aside past and present setbacks and failures and look with confidence to the new day called tomorrow.



# RONCALLI TUITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The goal of the ACSS is to make a Catholic education available to any family who chooses it. Because of the tremendous financial support of St. Mary's and Sacred Heart parishes our tuition is one of the lowest in the region.

The application is completed in TADS. <u>ACSS will pay the application fee</u>. Forms needed for completion: Tax forms 1040 (all schedules), W2, and 1099.
