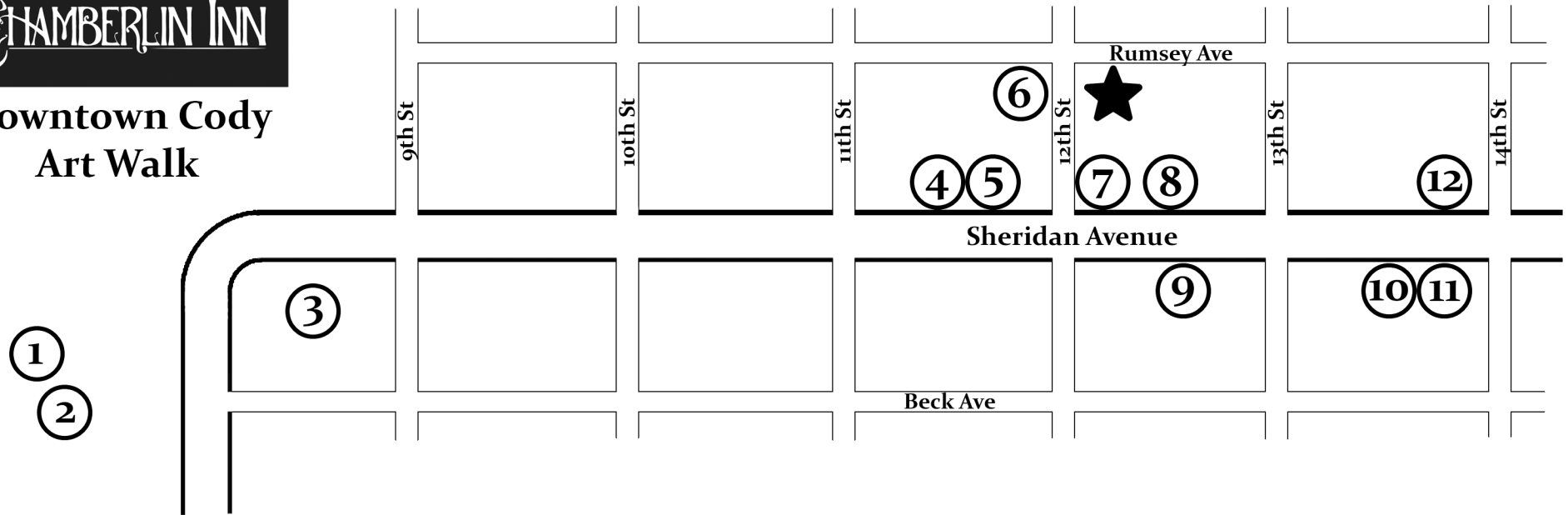

1. Whitney Western Art Museum

One of five museums located inside the Buffalo Bill Center of the West. A world-class collection of works by western masters through the ages. Prints of popular works available for purchase in Points West Market just inside the main entrance of the Center. Admission good for two days.

2. Buffalo Bill Art Show & Sale

Miniature works on sale inside the Buffalo Bill Center of the West June-September. Live auction and silent auction works on view August-September. Live Auction and Quick Draw events in September. Supports established and emerging Western artists, engages patrons of the arts, and benefits the prestigious Buffalo Bill Center of the West, Cody Country Chamber of Commerce and local art organizations. Museum admission encouraged but not required.

3. Cody Country Art League

Located in the Cody Country Chamber of Commerce & Visitor Center. Gallery and gift shop showcasing works for sale by promising new, emerging & established artists from Montana and Wyoming.

4. Simpson Gallagher Gallery

Established in 1994. A fine art gallery featuring some of America's leading representational artists. While focused primarily on landscape paintings and etchings and wildlife sculpture, the gallery continues to evolve exhibiting a broad range of work.

5. Big Horn Galleries

Established in 1982. Proud to present the finest in Western and Wildlife art and Landscapes of the West. Wide variety of subjects, style, media and price in paintings and sculpture by living and deceased artists as well as fine jewelry and original graphics. Excellent full service frame shop.
