Location

Be sure to pick a location that can offer both indoor and outdoor event spaces or a contingency plan in case of poor weather.

The Squire Tarbox Inn has twelve acres of historic property to work with, in addition to the our lovingly restored 1820s barn that presents a blank canvas for your perfect event. We offer space for elopements, intimate weddings, or larger celebrations of up to 125 guests. Gather your loved ones for cocktail hour on the barn's new back deck with built-in lighting, or dance the night away to live music with your partner close by.







Rooms

Hosting your wedding at a multipurpose venue like The Squire Tarbox Inn means you can have up to 24 guests stay on the property with you all weekend. Check in a few days early for some alone time with your future spouse, then host a welcome/rehearsal dinner on Friday, wedding on Saturday, and farewell brunch on Sunday.

Date

Marriage License

Working with a local officiant is the easiest way to take care of your marriage license, as they can help manage the official documentation at the conclusion of your ceremony. In Maine, each city or town is responsible for handling marriage licenses, but there are a few rules to determine where you should go to submit your marriage application.

-  If both you and your partner are Maine residents who live in different towns, you only need to apply once and can do so in either location.
-  If neither you nor your partner is a resident of Maine, you can apply in any town in the state.
-  If only you OR your partner is a Maine resident, you'll apply in the resident's town.
-  If you and your partner are Maine residents who live in the same city, you'll apply in the city in which you live.
-  In order to submit your marriage application, you'll need a photo ID and \$40 to cover the application fee. Once the marriage license is obtained, it's valid for 90 days.
