Motu To'opua

At Conrad Bora Bora Nui, we are deeply attached to the knowledge and history that built the soul and strength of Polynesian culture throughout the ages. Out of respect and awe for the hotel's magnificent location, we sought to discover and share its history. That is how we came to meet and listen to the Elders, those who still process amazing stories and ancient legends. They are living memory of all the mythical tales that make each island of the great Pacific community unique.

Our Banyan Tree



The shadows that can sometimes be seen on the moon are those of tumu'ora, a banyan tree whose many branches yielded enough bark for Hina (ambassador of beauty, charm, sweetness and joie de vivre in Bora Bora) to make tapa - the material used in ancient times to make clothing - for the gods.

Once, as Hina rested in the banyan tree, her foot broke a branch that flew across the sky, fell and took root on Bora Bora. That was the first tree of its kind in the world : a magnificent tree with aerial roots joining with branches; so tall and large that people can rest in its shadow.

That is how the banyan tree became a sacred universally respected tree.

You can admire this beautiful tree at Conrad Bora Bora Nui, right next to our Chinese restaurant, the Banyan.
