LOCATION: PROVO, UT INDUSTRY: NONPROFIT

Community Action Services and Food Bank is a nonprofit in Provo, UT offering multiple programs to help solve poverty and serve the community. Back in 2008, they started the Community Garden Program, which allows anyone in the community to pay a small fee to rent a plot of land for gardening. The program provides the land, water, as well as some gardening tools.

CHALLENGES

- Prevent theft of produce
- Keep trespassers off the property
- Monitor the garden 24/7 with limited access to power
