Fed up with crime, two American cities joined forces with LVT and the Loss Prevention Research Council to form the ACCESS Taskforce. LVT deployed 49 Live Units across Opelika, AL and Paducah, KY for a six month period. The results speak for themselves:

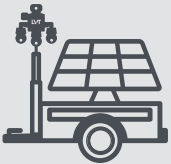

CRIME ON THE RISE

With crime rates ranking in the 90th percentile and year over year increases in retail crime, two communities were in a need of a change.
