Mazda Canada (MCI) is excited to announce the Mazda Driver Contingency Program for the 2021 Speedy Goat Time Trials Series. A reward program available to Mazda drivers who compete in the SGTT Championship Series driving a Mazda brand vehicle.

## Mazda Driver Eligibility

- Open to all Mazda drivers who compete with an MCI recognized Mazda brand vehicle in the Street, Tuner and Max divisions
- The Mazda driver must score in the final Overall SGTT Championship Series in a minimum 4 of the 6 events
- The Mazda driver and vehicle must comply with all SGTTS requirements

## **Mazda Contingency Payout**

- Contingency funds shall be paid based on a total year-end division points basis; not on a per event or per class basis
- Mazda drivers shall earn points within their vehicle class as determined by their fastest lap times within their class. Drivers shall accumulate these event points within their Street, Tuner or Max division based on the following points system:

1st	2nd	3rd	4th	5th	6th	7th	8th
10	8	6	5	4	3	2	1

- Any yearend tie within a division shall be broken by the competitor with the most higher place finishes. If still tied, then comparing the fastest lap times for the tied competitors at the events they are both scoring, with the faster lap times winning. Example: Driver A best scores in events: 1, 2, 3, 4; Driver B best scores in events: 3, 4, 5, 6; lap times from only events 3 and 4 will be compared; the fastest total time will be deemed the winner
- Based on the year-end series points accumulated, Mazda Driver Contingency funds shall be paid to the top three Mazda drivers in each of Street, Tuner and Max divisions as follows:

1st	2nd	3rd
\$400	\$300	\$150
