Title: Section 22a Modern Slavery Police Transformation Programme (MSPTU)										
<b>Summary</b> : The modern slavery police transformation unit (MSPTU) launched in April 2017, to provide dedicated specialist teams to support all 43 police forces in England and Wales, to transform the Police response to modern slavery. The unit is designed to deliver improvements in the efficiency and the effectiveness of the police response, filling gaps identified by the National Policing Lead and summarised by Caroline Haughey (2016) who reviewed the operation of the Modern Slavery Act on behalf of the Home Office.										
Tackling modern slavery effectively requires a broad range of skills. As such, the MSPTU includes 70 law enforcement specialists working in several interconnected, multi-disciplinary and often multi-agency teams, coordinated through a senior management team. The pace of change within the UK's cross government modern slavery and wider policing landscape prompts continuous review of the most impactful contributions that the unit makes to disrupt this crime.
