Title: Acumen Support for Aspire & Derwentside Mind				
Executive Summary:				
<b>Derwentside Mind:</b> The cost of the Acumen proposal is £4,000. Local members of parliament Laura Pidcock and Kevan Jones wrote to OPCVC in February 2018 asking for financial support for Derwentside Mind. The force lead on suicide prevention felt that any investment would be of value in better understanding and preventing suicide. As part of the funding, Derwentside Mind will be asked to help us to understand the following: where Mind's referrals come from; what gaps does Mind fill; and what gaps in service provision (to support those at risk of suicide) are caused by current referral processes (health service and other organisations).				
<b>Aspire:</b> The cost of the Acumen proposal is £5,600. Aspire are the first organisation whose volunteers received the peer mentor training. Aspire is a well-regarded organisation, which is why the Community Peer Mentor Coordinator was drawn to them. The OPCVC policy lead believes that Aspire delivers a good service to its clients. As part of the funding, Aspire will be asked to help us to understand where their referrals come from and the range of support they offer; and share details about their existing capacity.				
The proposal is to fund both pieces of work from the police transformation monies as these two proposals involve working with 'communities of interest', which both Aspire and Derwentside Mind represent.
