

SANI-COTE (ANTIMICROBIAL CARCASS WASH)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Sani-Cote (PAA) is an antimicrobial agent which has been formulated for use as a carcass, parts, trim and organ wash, process water and scalder treatment. It is specially formulated to adhere to 21 CFR 173.370 for peroxyacetic acid, hydrogen peroxide and stabilizer ratios. When used as directed, Sani-Cote will enable excellent anti-microbial washing and/or scalding results and will provide the highest level of food safety possible for the process. Recommended concentrations are general use only. Always ask for specific recommendations for your particular application.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply Sani-Cote by adding to spray, rinse, wash, dip, chill, scald or other processing water. Sani-Cote is an antimicrobial agent for application on whole, half or quarter red meat carcasses and red meat carcass parts, trim and organs. When used as directed Sani-Cote reduces microbial contamination that may cause spoilage or decay. Sani-Cote also reduces contamination of the pathogenic bacteria Salmonella, Listeria monocytogenes, Campylobacter and Escherichia coli 0157:H7 on meat and poultry carcasses, carcass parts, trim and organs. Sani-Cote is approved for no rinse applications at recommended concentrations.

CAUTION

PAA is safe to use on aluminum and stainless steel. Do not use on mild steel, copper, or galvanized. Sani-Cote is corrosive to mild steel, copper, or galvanized.

PAA solutions which are actively decomposing are potentially hazardous. Observe the following precautions to prevent decomposition:

Avoid all contaminants, especially dirt, caustic, reducing agents, and metals. Contamination and impurities will reduce shelf life and can induce decomposition. Never return unused portions of sanitizer to the original container. Do not store near combustible materials. Store only in the original vented containers. To ensure proper venting, keep drums upright and do not stack. Keep drums closed when not in use. Avoid damage to containers.

SAFETY

When handling concentrated chemicals, follow the guidelines listed in the Safety Data Sheets (SDS). PPE must be worn at all times. Avoid eye and skin contact. Any direct contact with eyes can cause irreversible damage due to the strong oxidizing nature of PAA. Always use in a well ventilated area.

STORAGE

To maintain product quality, store PAA at or below 86°F (30°C). Do not store Sani-Cote in direct sunlight. Provide good ventilation of storage areas.
