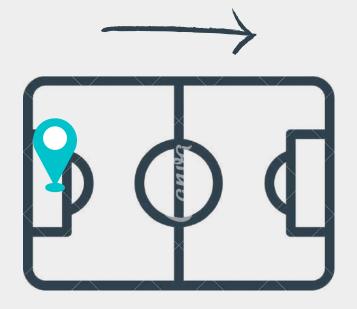

TACTICAL ANALYSIS







His good body and tactical positioning are valuable tools that he possesses. He takes care of where he is at, according to the rival's distribution of play. He is quick to move. Also, his aggressiveness allows him to block the ball with any part of his body.

His tactical positioning is an advantage in front of the attacker. He is elastic to reach it both horizontally and vertically (as said before, his aggressiveness allows him to block the ball with part of his body). He is agile to react with his arms and use his potency to jump to the ball.

Since he is elastic, aggressive and well-positioned, he is goalkeeper who constantly makes blocks. He is quick to react and move, jump to the ball to either right or left side and also to participate in a second action while being on the ground.

TACTICAL ANALYSIS





Being an attentive, well-positioned, and quick to react goalkeeper make him a great one. In addition, his angle of approach to the attacker is something where he stands out. He has a good timing to come out of his zone in 1v1 actions. He positions his body well to block different types of shots.



His good interpretation of play and timing to come out are shown when the rival tries to play direct in behind the defensive line, making lateral crosses or in set pieces. He moves fast and uses his punch to clearance (he does not allow second actions).

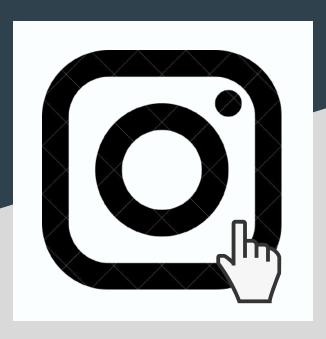
