Nursery News Friday 24th February 2023

This week in Nursery we have focused on the book 'Hike' (Peter Oswold) for book week. This book is all about adventure, nature, minibeasts and foraging. The children designed their own adventure packs, discussing what we would need to take on our hike. This included maps, binoculars, torches and magnifying glasses to spot the little creatures and insects along the way. The children enjoyed going on their own minibeast hunt outside in the playground - using the magnifying glass to find snails, slugs, worms and ants.

The children have been busy singing and dancing, learning the Nursery Rhyme 'Jack and Jill'. Within the theme of adventure and minibeasts, we have also been singing 'Incy Wincy Spider' and 'The animals went in two by two'. In Phonics, the children have been focusing on oral blending and segmenting (breaking up words and putting them back together) to support the development of their speech and language. In Maths, the pupils have been practicing their number recognition skills and ordering numbers 1-10.

Next week, we will be focusing on the topic of Spring and seasonal changes, learning about the key features of Spring. Next Friday (3rd March), we would love the children to come into school dressed up as their favourite book character in celebration of World Book Day. We also invite the children to bring in a favourite book to share with the class at storytime.
