Privacy Policy

Effective 09/13/2023

Revision Health Services (“RHS”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) has updated our Website Privacy Policy (“Policy”). Please read this policy carefully. It is your choice whether or not to provide personal information to us. If you chose to do so, you are giving us your express consent to use, process, and disclose your personal information as set forth in this policy.

Introduction

We respect the privacy of our customers and website uses and have developed this Policy to demonstrate our commitment to protecting your privacy.

Scope of this policy

This policy is intended to describe our practices with respect to the collection, use, and maintenance (“Processing”) of personal information related to uses of our website. For the purpose of this Policy, the term “Sites” shall refer to www.revisionhealthservices.com. In this policy “personal information” means information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. Personal information does not include aggregate information or de-identified information, meaning that the information can no longer be attributed to an identifiable natural person without the use of additional information.

Personal information is required for us to be able to provide some services to you. In addition, some of the services we provide require that we disclose your personal information to third parties, such as to companies that help us to provide our services.

Our sites may contain links to other websites that do not operate under this Policy. These third-party websites may independently solicit and collect personal information from you and, in some instances, provide us with information about your activities on those websites. We encourage you to review the privacy statements of all third-party websites you visit to understand their information practices.

While we strongly support the protection of privacy on the Internet, we do not have control over, and cannot be responsible for, the actions of other third parties. We encourage you to review each such third party’s privacy statement and understand its privacy practices before providing personal information directly to it.

We collect personal information to operate effectively and provide you with the best experience with our services. You provide some of this information directly, such as when you create an account, make a purchase, or contact us for support. We get some of your information, such as your IP address, by recording how you interact with our Sites.

We may receive and collect certain personal information automatically, as outlined elsewhere in this Policy, and including analytics regarding our sites, information your Internet browser automatically sends when you visit our sites, and information collected by cookies and web beacons. We may collect personal information that can identify you such as your name and email address, and other information that does not identify you.

We ask for and may collect personal information about you such as your name, address, e-mail address, birth date, and telephone number. We also may request information about your interests and activities, your gender and age, and other demographic information. Our Sites may provide you with the ability to enter (directly, or by authorizing us to download the information from a third party such as a social networking site or application) personal information such as contacts or lists of friends. These or related applications may also allow you to provide information directly to social networking sites including information about your purchases, physical location, or comments. If you sign up to receive promotional communications or notifications from us, we may ask you to provide personal information so that we can provide these to you.

Information that we Collect from you on our sites

We also may use various technologies to collect information from your computer or device and about your activities on our sites.

How do we use your information?

We may use the information we collect from you in the following ways:

To provide better service to you when responding to your customer service requests.

To administer a contest, promotion, survey or other site feature.

To send emails regarding your interests or other products and services.

How do we protect visitor information?

We do not use vulnerability scanning or scanning to PCI standards. We use regular Malware Scanning. We do not use an SSL certificate. We do not need an SSL as we only provide articles and information. We never ask for sensitive information such as credit card numbers.

COPPA (Children Online Privacy Protection Act)

When it comes to the collection of personal information from children under 13 years of age, the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) makes the child's parents responsible. The Federal Trade Commission, the nation's consumer protection agency, enforces the COPPA Rule which spells out what operators of websites and online services must do to protect children's privacy and safety online. We do not specifically market to children under 13.

Information collected automatically. We may automatically collect information from you when you visit our sites. This information may include your IP address, your browser type and language, access times, the content of any undeleted cookies that your browser previously

accepted from us, referring or exit website address, internet service provider, date/time stamp, operating system, locale and language preferences, and system configuration information.

Cookies. When you visit our Sites, we may assign your computer one or more cookies to facilitate access to our site and to personalize your online experience. Through the use of a cookie, we also may automatically collect information about your online activity on our site, such as the web pages you visit, the links you click, and the searches you conduct on our site. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on a user's computer for record keeping purposes. Cookies can be either session cookies or persistent cookies. A session cookie expires when you close your browser and is used to make it easier for you to navigate our Sites. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive for an extended period of time

How we use your personal information

We use the personal information we collect for a variety of purposes. The legal bases for our Processing of personal information will depend on the specific context in which we collect it. We will retain personal information for as long as it is needed. General uses may include managing your account and provide you with customer support; communication, research, enforce terms and conditions, and legal compliance.

We share your personal information as necessary to provide the services you request, including sharing information with third party service providers; when required by law; to protect rights and safety, and with your consent. We do not sell your personal information.

Authorized service providers: We may share your personal information with our authorized service providers that perform certain services on our behalf. These services may include fulfilling orders, processing credit card payments, delivering packages, providing customer service and marketing assistance, performing business and sales analysis, supporting our sites' functionality, and supporting contests, promotions, sweepstakes, surveys and other features offered through our Sites. These service providers may have access to personal information needed to perform their functions but are not permitted to share or use such information for any other purposes.

Other situations: We also may disclose your information:

In response to a subpoena or similar investigative demand, a court order, or a request for cooperation from a law enforcement or other government agency; to establish or exercise our legal rights; to defend against legal claims; or as otherwise required by law. In such cases, we may raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us;

When we believe disclosure is appropriate in connection with efforts to investigate, prevent, or take other action regarding illegal activity, suspected fraud or other wrongdoing; to protect and defend the rights, property or safety of our company, our users, our employees, or others; to comply with applicable law or cooperate with law enforcement; or to enforce our terms and conditions or other agreements or policies.

Aggregated and Non-personal Information: We may share aggregated and non-personal information we collect under any of the circumstances set forth in this Policy. We may also share it with third parties to develop and deliver targeted advertising on our sites and on websites and apps of third parties. We may combine non-personal information we collect with additional non-personal information collected from other sources. We also may share aggregated information with third parties, including advisors, advertisers and investors, for the purpose of conducting general business analysis. For example, we may tell our advertisers the number of visitors to our sites and the most popular features or services accessed. This information does not contain any personal information and may be used to develop website content and services that we hope you and other users will find of interest and to target content and advertising.

Opt-Out

At any time you can choose to no longer receive commercial or promotional emails or newsletters from us by modifying your email preferences by selecting the "Opt-Out" link found in the footer of the communication or on our sites or by contacting us at revisionhealthservices.com with the word "unsubscribe" in the email subject line.

Changes to this Policy

We will occasionally update this Policy to reflect material changes in our privacy practices. If we make any material changes in the way we collect, use, and/or share your personal information, we will notify you by posting the modified Policy on our Sites and indicating at the top of the Policy the date it was last updated. We may also notify you by sending you an e-mail. We encourage you to review the Policy each time you visit our site, to see if this Policy has been updated since your last visit to make sure you understand how your personal information will be processed.

Consent to the use of cookies.

For our website to function properly we use cookies. To obtain your valid consent for the use and storage of cookies in the browser you use to access our website and to properly document this we use a consent management platform: CookieFirst. This technology is provided by Digital Data Solutions BV, Plantage Middenlaan 42a, 1018 DH, Amsterdam, The Netherlands. Website: <https://cookiefirst.com> referred to as CookieFirst.

When you access our website, a connection is established with CookieFirst's server to give us the possibility to obtain valid consent from you to the use of certain cookies. CookieFirst then stores a cookie in your browser in order to be able to activate only those cookies to which you have consented and to properly document this. The data processed is stored until the predefined storage period expires or you request to delete the data. Certain mandatory legal storage periods may apply notwithstanding the aforementioned.

CookieFirst is used to obtain the legally required consent for the use of cookies. The legal basis for this is article 6(1)(c) of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Data processing agreement

We have concluded a data processing agreement with CookieFirst. This is a contract required by data protection law, which ensures that data of our website visitors is only processed in accordance with our instructions and in compliance with the GDPR.

Server log files

Our website and CookieFirst automatically collect and store information in so-called server log files, which your browser automatically transmits to us. The following data is collected:

- Your consent status or the withdrawal of consent
- Your anonymised IP address
- Information about your Browser
- Information about your Device
- The date and time you have visited our website
- The webpage url where you saved or updated your consent preferences
- The approximate location of the user that saved their consent preference
- A universally unique identifier (UUID) of the website visitor that clicked the cookie banner
