#### **Advance Notice of Highway Works - Clifton upon Dunsmore Village Traffic Calming scheme**

I am writing to inform you of planned highway works in connection with the above scheme which are due to commence on **Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2018**.

The extents and locations of the works are shown on the attached drawing. There will also be some complementary works to provide 7.5 tonne weight restriction signs at a number of locations on surrounding roads.

#### How long will the works take to complete?

The works are expected to be complete by the end of August.

#### Who will be carrying out the works?

The works will be managed and overseen by Warwickshire County Council's Highways Partner Contractor – Balfour Beatty Living Places, who will be using a number of specialist sub-contractors to undertake the works.

#### Will there be any access & traffic restrictions during the works?

While every effort will be made to keep the disruption to a minimum during the works, there will be some disruption and inconvenience. Carrying out the works in phases and over the school summer holiday period when traffic levels are reduced will help to limit the impact of the works. Also, working times on busier roads will be restricted to avoid the peak traffic times in the morning and evening.

There will be need to put in place temporary traffic lights or other similar traffic management system to safely control the movement of traffic around the works. The majority of works will be undertaken Monday to Friday between the hours 9.00am and 4.00pm, although it may be necessary to carry out some works outside these times or at weekends.

There will also be a number of temporary road closures, these will be of short duration (1 or 2 days) and will be daytime closures only. The timing of road closures will be largely dependent upon progress, all closures will be signed on street in advance of the works. During the closures through traffic will be diverted via alternative signed diversion routes, access for local residents and visitors will be maintained at all times.

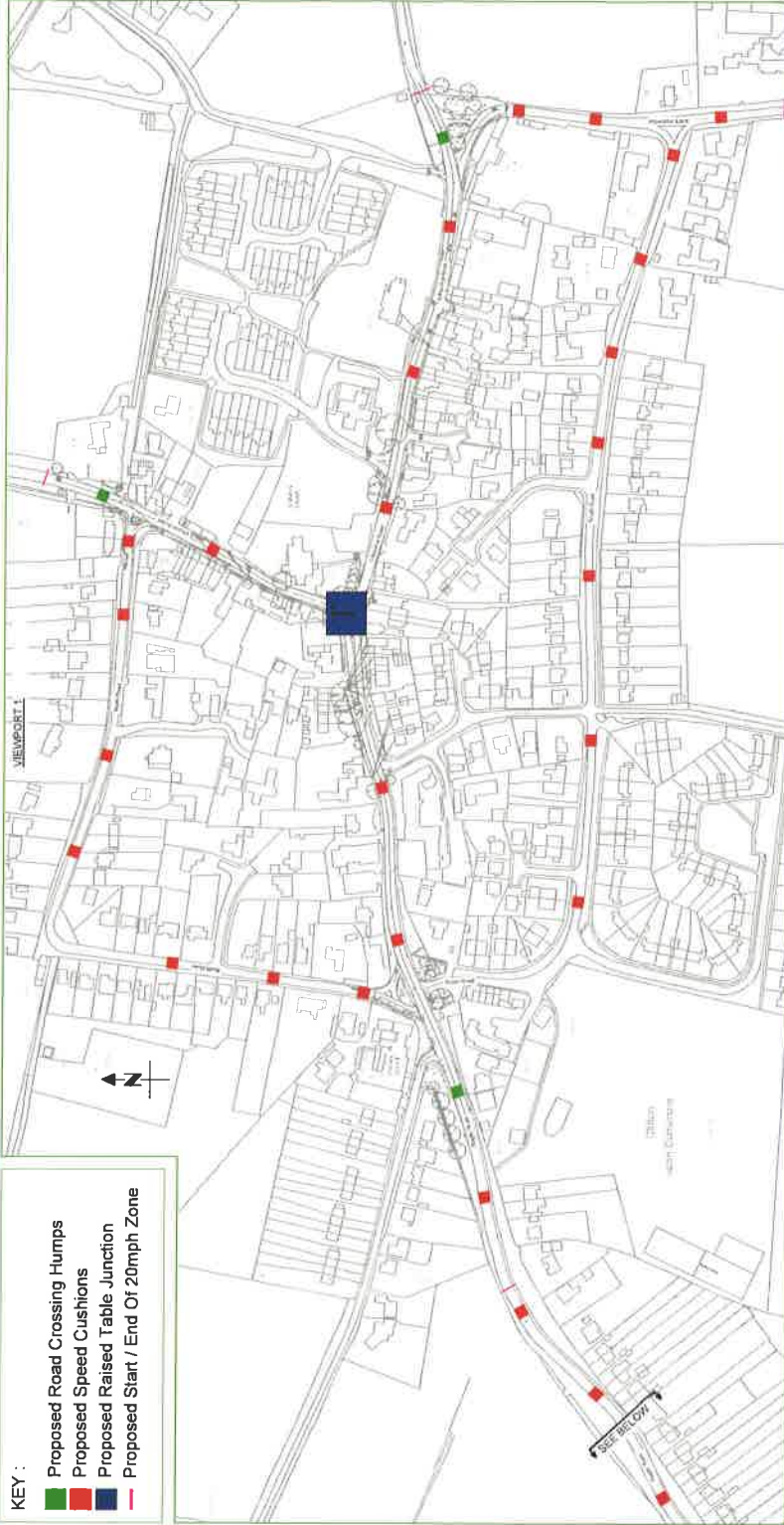

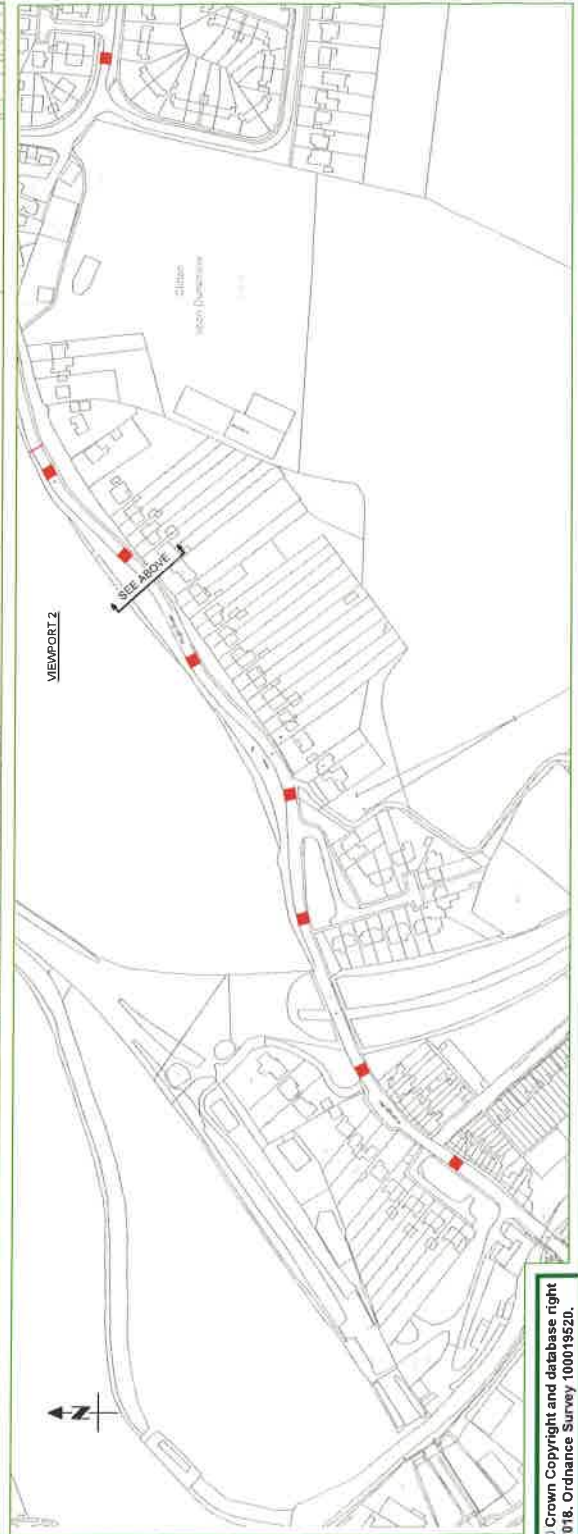
