# How Outreach is Building Healthy Lives in New York

- Quality substance use disorder (SUD) and mental health (MH) treatment for teens and adults using evidence-based, multi-phase models in individual and group counseling
- Direct link to Outreach's safe and supportive gender-specific community residences
- Enhanced outpatient program for women and women with children

## Outpatient Treatment



- Compassionate residential care for teens 13-18 years of age struggling with drug and/or alcohol use.
- On-site DOE/BOCES schools in adolescent residences
- OASAS-certified rehabilitation & reintegration care for adult men and reintegration care for women (gender-specific facilities) transitioning from intensive residential care

## Residential Treatment



- Medication-Assisted Treatment (buprenorphine, naltrexone) for opioid and alcohol use disorders, as clinically indicated.
- Onsite primary care available at all programs
- Multidisciplinary teams to address co-occurring disorders
