

Overview – AEB Subcontracting 2021/2022

Hull College is looking to procure delivery partners to deliver high quality training, low risk provision through a subcontracting arrangement, this will be funded through the college's Adult Education Budget (AEB) for the 2021/2022 academic year*.

Delivery must take place to either unemployed or employed learners based in the Humber region and eligibility must meet with the Education and Skills Funding Agency's (ESFA) AEB funding rules** ;

Successful applicants are also required to meet with the requirements of the ESFA's subcontracting funding rules***.

The procured delivery must complement the College's delivery and not duplicate its own provision. It must meet the needs of individuals and meet with local labour market information and the Humber Local Enterprise Partnership's employment and skills strategy****

There is currently £450,000 funding available and we are looking for applications around £225,000 per organisation.

Successful applicants will be expected to work with the college providing progression routes for learners.
