WHERE TO **VOTE IN PERSON**

To vote in person or drop off an early ballot, you can go to ANY Vote Center across Maricopa County.

Find out where to vote in person or drop off your ballot at locations.maricopa.vote

HOW TO VOTE BY MAIL

We recommend filling out your early ballot and sending it back immediately after receiving it.

Mail back your ballot by November 1st!

Your ballot must be received by 7 p.m. on Election Day.

Fill in the bubble next to your candidate with a black ballpoint pen.

STEP TWO

Sign, date, and write your phone number on the green envelope.



STEP THREE

Fold ballot and insert into green, prepaid envelope.



STEP FOUR

Mail by November 1, or drop off at any Vote Center by November 8.
