

With summer not too far away, liposuction and abdominoplasty procedures are also popular options, each of them requiring an amount of downtime and the wearing of compression garments. Mr Bialostocki's experience and good judgement, combined with the most modern advancements and well-established techniques ensure your optimal outcome is achieved.
