A Graduation Prayer

First, let me say, "Congratulations!" to all of our graduates this year. You have passed one of the many road marks which are set before you in this life. But as with anything in life, the end of one road is really just the beginning of another. Now you will all begin traveling on a new road by going to college, starting new jobs, or continuing your education in other ways. I am sure that all of you here today have goals and wishes that you have made for your life, things that you want to accomplish or that you would like to have. As Christians, we have the awesome privilege to bow before our Heavenly Father in prayer to ask him for what we need.

What will you ask for?

In Ephesians 3:14-21, Paul is praying for the Christians in the city of Ephesus and provides us an excellent model for our praying. Here are three things that not only should graduates pray for, but we should ALL pray for:

Set Jesus above all! We should be praying that God would help us let Jesus rule in every area of our lives, which is not always easy to do. We need help in this and

Paul is helping us realize that help is available! Let's pick up what Paul says in Eph. 3, beginning with verse 14, "For this reason I bow my knees before the Father,"¹⁵from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name, ¹⁶that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with power through His Spirit in the inner man."

2) Share Jesus wherever you may go. Wherever God may take you, be sure to share the love of Christ. We must be *rooted and grounded in the love of Christ*.

Eph. 3:17b says, **"...and that you, being rooted and grounded in love..."**

Paul used the image of the importance of a root system for the vitality of a plant and says that we are to be rooted and grounded in the love of Christ.

Once we know the love of Christ, we HAVE to share it!

3) Serve Jesus by always doing your best! Trust in what God can and will do through you! Paul ends his prayer by saying in verses 20-21, **"Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all that we ask or think, according to the power that works within us, ²¹to Him be the glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations forever and ever. Amen."** *Will you be a person*

who lives by God's standards? Here is the bottom line: Far more important than WHAT we do with our lives, is WHO we become in our living. Many of you may be asking, "What am I going to do with my life?" No matter what career you choose, you can know that God is interested in what you do, no question. But the far more important question is: WHO will I become. Will I set Jesus above all? Will I share the love of Jesus with others? And will I serve Jesus by always doing my very best? With God's help, we CAN say YES to all three of these questions! PRAISE THE LORD!
