- O A copy of the written procedure of the building work requiring protection, detailing the methods, materials and equipment needed to carry out the works, including the measures to be incorporated to ensure the public and workers are not put at risk during the works.
- o Evidence of public liability insurance to cover any persons or property that may suffer injury or damage as a result of the erection of precautions or after the erection of precautions.
