Domestic Animals Act 1994

All cats and dogs three months and older must be registered. The owner of a dog or cat who fails to register their animal may be liable for a penalty. For a child under the age of 18, the dog or cat must be registered in a parent's or guardian's name.

New Animals

All new applications to register a dog or cat cannot be accepted unless the dog or cat has a microchip implant (of which, acceptable proof must be provided), This includes dogs/cats moving into the Municipality from another Council.

Registration Fees for Dogs & Cats

Standard Fee: \$165, Reduced Fee: \$51.50, Declared Dangerous/Menacing Dog \$230, Non-Residential Guard Dog \$165, Restricted Breed Dog: \$230. Non-Desexed Dog <12 months old: \$51.50.

You are eligible for a reduced registration fee if your pet is:

- Desexed
- Has an obedience certificate issued by a Government approved organisation.
- Over 10 years of age.
- Kept for working stock.
- Kept for breeding by the proprietor of a registered domestic animal business.
- A hound registered with the GMA that is microchipped.
- Owned by a member of an applicable organisation approved by the Minister.

Pensioners

Holders of eligible pension cards are entitled to a 50% reduction of the standard fee, reduced fee and the non desexed animal under 12 months of age fees listed. Please present your card in person at the time of registration. Please note health care card holders are not entitled to reduced fees for pensioners.

Dogs to be placed on lead

Wellington Shire Council has put into place an order under Section 26 (2) of the Domestic Animals Act 1994. As from 19 October 2017, all dogs are required under this order to be placed on a lead at all times in designated dog on lead areas unless otherwise specified:

1st Offence Penalty 2 Penalty Units 2nd Offence Penalty 4 Penalty Units

Documents

For entitlements to reduced registration fees the owner of the animal must produce proof of sterilisation, memberships of applicable organisation, obedience papers, breeding licence, statutory declaration or tax return for proof of working dog status.

Excess Animal Permits

An owner or occupier of property must not keep or allow to be kept without a permit, a greater number of each type of animal other than as set out below;

State Government Levy

Registration fees include the State Government Levy pursuant to the Domestic Animals Act 1994.

Penalties

Owners of unregistered animals may receive on-the-spot fines for each animal. Local Laws Officers conduct random spot checks throughout Wellington Shire.

Privacy

The personal information requested on this form is being collected by Council for the enforcement and administration of animal control in accordance with Section 10 & 18 of the Domestic Animals Act 1994. The personal information will be used by Council and its Contractors/Agents for that primary purpose or directly related purposes and may be disclosed as required to do by the law. The applicant may apply to Council for access and/or amendment of the information.

Lifetime Tags

Replacement tags can be obtained from our Customer Service Centres at a cost of \$6.00.
