LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Thank you for your continued dedication to getting people back to work and on a path toward stability!

2022 was a year of transition for Small Sums as we carefully navigated out of a global pandemic and into a new, post-Covid environment. We served more youth experiencing homelessness through our Young and Hopeful Program and supported folks precariously hosed through our Keep Your Place program. We also instituted a new Keep Your Job program to support clients with retaining employment and moving toward long-term economic and housing stability.

In 2022 we welcomed two senior leaders to our team, Tosheed Thompson as Assistant Director of Outreach and Andrea Kish-Bailey as Executive Director. Throughout these transitions, we continued to serve workers with personalized care and attention. In fact, we served more annually than ever before, outfitting 824 individuals with the work gear, tools, training, and transportation needed to start a new job.

Each worker has a unique story of resilience and hope, and we are pleased to be a part of their journey out of homelessness. As we look forward to 2023, we plan to outfit over 1,000 workers, serve more youth experiencing homelessness, and expand our Keep Your Job program.

Homelessness is a complex problem. Our simple, practical, powerful mission is one dignified step toward stability. But we can not do it alone. We rely on community partnerships to ensure each new worker has the resources to retain gainful employment and secure safe, affordable housing. And we depend on you, our generous community, to support this critical work.

Dressed & Ready

We outfit workers with required work shoes, boots, and clothes that are well-fitting and high-quality.



Tools for the Job

We provide tools for construction workers, welders, barbers, chefs, and other trades.



On The Bus

We provide reliable transportation via 31-day unlimited bus passes or gas cards for the first few months of employment.



Professional Development, Certifications, and Licenses

We cover union dues, professional licensing test costs, renewal fees, certifications, training, and more.



Keep Your Place

We provide prevention support to individuals who are behind on rent and at risk of homelessness.



Keep the Job

We provide resources to help workers keep their jobs with a goal of long-term economic and housing stability.



Young & Hopeful

Through partnership, we work with youth organizations to outfit teenage and young adult clients with the required work items to participate in job placement and training programs.



MEET CARLOS

Carlos is staying at a Catholic Charities emergency shelter, where he learned about Small Sums. Over his life, he's had many temp jobs and is excited to be somewhere he can ground himself permanently. Carlos has a background in logistics and warehousing and is motivated about his new position with Northern Iron and the possibilities that come along with it. "I want to grow within the company and eventually become a supervisor," Carlos told us.

We drove Carlos to Loeffler Shoes during his appointment and purchased the metatarsal boots he needed to begin work. Carlos also received a Small Sums Back to Work package, including work pants, t-shirts, Bombas socks, and a donated Minnesota United FC jacket. Finding resources for food continues to be his biggest challenge, and we were happy to provide items from our food shelf and connect Carlos with other community resources.

Looking back 10 years ago, Carlos isn't happy where he was. His previous situation continues to motivate him to never live like that again. "The difference," Carols exclaimed, "is my mindset, the people I surround myself with, and my overall environment." He says these things keep him grounded as he works toward returning home to his wife and children.

When workers reach us, they have already found a verifiable job, a testament to their resilience and determination under daunting circumstances.




