- > Develops and directs the implementation of policies and programs within the assigned unit
- > Directs the performance of Los Angeles Metro's security staff and the services performed by consultants and contractors to ensure successful implementation and completion of security projects
- > Partners with the Capital Projects team to request and manage security assets
- > Oversees the agency's security and law enforcement contracts
- > Directs responses to major incidents and inquiries on operational issues and reports
- > Provides expertise in conducting technical studies and analysis related to critical infrastructure protection in the mass transit environment
- > Ensures implementation of programs and procedures to improve service quality, increase employee and service productivity and maintain sound fiscal practices
- > Provides direction and makes recommendations to solve complex operational issues and problems
- > Reviews physical security threats associated with perimeter intrusion and mass casualty threats, and recommends adjustments to deployment of personnel to address emerging trends or patterns
- > Represents Metro before public agencies, the business community, labor unions, and the public
- > Directs the conducting of studies, investigations, and analyses at the direction of executive staff and Board of Directors, including reports of findings and recommendations
- > Prepares reports and oral presentations for Metro's Board of Directors
- > Supervises subordinate staff
- > Contributes to ensuring that the EEO policies and programs of Metro are carried out
