Professor Walter L. Pilant passed away peacefully at the age of 86 on December 15th, 2017. Born in Los Angeles, California, he graduated from Caltech in 1953 with a BS, and from UCLA in 1960 with a PhD. He served in the Army, and moved to Pittsburgh in 1963 where he taught geophysics for over 30 years at the University of Pittsburgh.
