Events

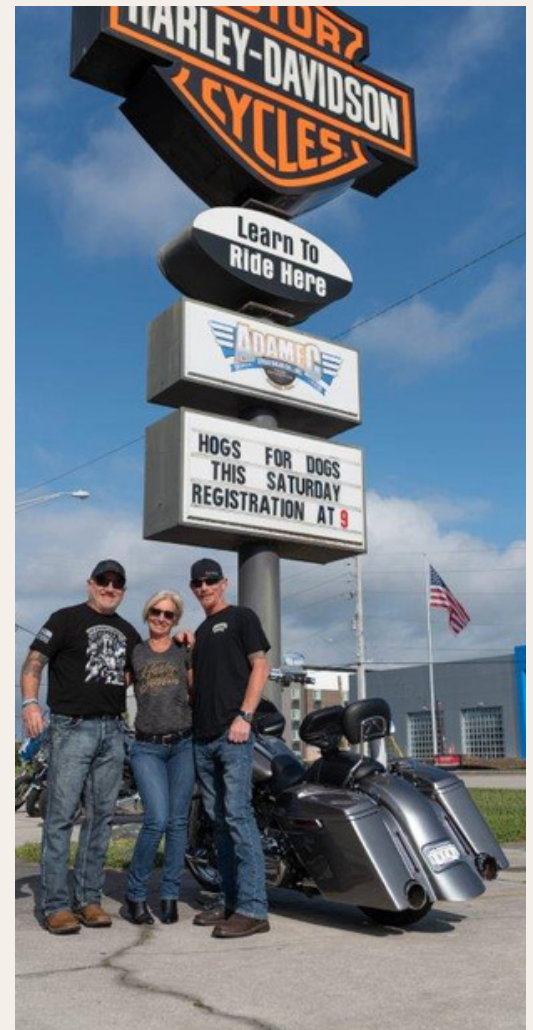
