Framed 3 Yard Quilt

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1

 $\overline{\text{Cut } 1 - 6}$ -3/4" wide strip. Cut 1 – 6-3/4 x 6-3/4" square, Cut 4 triangles from square.

Cut 4 – 6" wide strips. Cut 25 squares.

Fabric 2

Cut 1 - 3-5/8: wide strip, Cut $4 - 3-5/8 \times 3-5/8$ " squares, Cut 8 triangles from 4 squares Cut 1 – 3-1/4" wide strip. Cut 4 rectangles 6" long. Cut 3- 6-3/8" wide strips. Cut 16 squares. Cut 32 rectangles from 16 squares.

Fabric 3.

Cut 3- 6-3/8" wide strips. Cut 16 squares. Cut 32 rectangles from 16 squares. Cut 2 – 6" wide strips. Cut 12 squares.


Sewing Instructions:

To make saw tooth border, sew triangles together. Next, sew the small triangles from Fabric 2 to the triangle from Fabric 1.


Now you can assemble the rows by following the image of quilt.

Sew rows together. Add borders, sewing sides first, then top and bottom.


Quilt as desired, and add binding made from pieced leftover fabrics, or use a piece of stash.
