

International & Indigenous Language Elementary Program (IILEP) Fall/Winter 2023-2024



The International & Indigenous Languages Elementary Program (IILEP) is offered by St. Charles Adult & Continuing Education, a part of the Hamilton-Wentworth Catholic District School Board.

The focus of the Elementary Program is to offer children an opportunity to develop and maintain the ability to listen, speak and write a new language or the language of the home or heritage. The program is offered in addition to the regular school curriculum, and enrolment is voluntary.

Eligibility

Pupils enrolled in Junior Kindergarten to Grade 8 in a publicly funded day school or in a private school in Ontario. Any pupil who will be four (4) years of age by the end of the calendar year, December 31, 2023, is also eligible to register. A pupil who is home-schooled, is not funded, and is required to pay a \$100 fee to participate in the program. Previous knowledge of the language is not required. Children may learn a language that is not of their heritage.

Registration

Registration opens on August 21st. takes place on or before the first day of the program. This is a continuous intake and students may register throughout the year.

The form requires your child's Ontario Education Number (OEN), which can be found on your child's report card.

Children entering Year 1 Kindergarten must show proof of age.

Classes are subject to sufficient enrolment and availability of qualified instructors

Class Routines

Online/virtual: Have your child log in 5 minutes before class starts.

In-person: Have your child wait outside for the instructor to lead into class.

Attendance and punctuality are essential and expected throughout the entire program.

Inform your child's instructor should your child be absent from class.
