early childhood institute clubs

Our clubs are designed to promote early childhood learning and development through play. Cognitive, social and physical skills are explored through science, art, movement and literature; all designed to meet the growing needs of young children.

Below are the fee-based, 1-hour clubs for the 2021-2022 school year.

11-WEEK CLUB SESSIONS ARE \$275 FOR MEMBERS & \$300 FOR NON-MEMBERS

Registration must be completed 1 week prior to first class. No walk-ins.

tuesdays RHYTHM, GROOVE AND SING!

This immersive class includes an introduction to dance, choreography, traditional songs and musical games. Through cooperative play, music, dance and creative self-expression, children will develop their self-confidence, social-emotional skills, spatial awareness and literacy skills. At the end of the fall/spring session, children will host a Rhythm, Groove and Sing Concert.

wednesdays MINI-MUSICAL THEATER

In this class children will learn to combine acting, singing and dancing. They will be encouraged to think creatively through imagination, enhance their communication skills and learn lessons in empathy and conflict resolution. Join us for a theater performance at the end of the fall/spring session!

thursdays MICHIMU JR. CHEF

Our Jr. Chef classes are hands-on classes designated to create and promote healthy eating habits, teach basic cooking skills and expand children's knowledge of nutrition and food-related vocabulary. At the end of the fall/spring session, families will be invited to a dinner hosted by our Jr. Chefs!

CHILDREN EXPERIMENT AND EXPLORE WITH STEAM

This class creates an environment that integrates the STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics) program, which promotes scientific thinking by supporting a young child's exploration and experimentation with the world around them. It provides children with the foundation for critical thinking and problem solving, including identifying problems, making predictions, hypothesizing, investigating and recording scientific events. Each week will build onto the next and at the end of our 11-week program the children will host a STEAM fair.

fridays SPORT AND RECREATION | 2:45-3:30PM*

This club is designed for fun play while improving agility, coordination and character building. Children will be introduced to the fundamentals of soccer, baseball and tennis, and develop skills at their own pace.
