BBTCA On Site Process for Contractors – Terminal

The following processes are to be followed when contractors are on site performing work in the Terminal for Nieuport. This process applies whether an escort is required or contractor possess a valid RAIC.

Process:

- Contractor must report to the Ports Toronto Security Office to check in /register and obtain security escort (if required)
- Contractors must contact the Duty Manager on 416-203-6942 ext. 17, prior to commencing any work on site, and advise the security office when work is complete.
- Contractor must possess a copy, paper or electronic, of approved work order while working on site and produce if/when asked.
- All work post security requires contractors to be processed through NPS-T near Domestic Security, or Bag Room, this includes work in CBSA areas.
- Contractors must follow instructions outlined in the Notice of Work. Any discrepancies must be immediately escalated to Nieuport.
- Any incident on site must be immediately reported the Airport Non-Emergency Line 416-203-6942 ext. 10, for an emergency please call 416-203-1910.

Failure to adhere to the above may result in suspension or termination of access to work on site.
