

Accessibility and Emergency Care Consent

Psychology telemedicine is a method of providing mental health services via interactive video communications and/or the electronic transmission of information. This means that you will be treated by your Psychologist from a distant location rather than a face-to-face encounter/visit.

By signing this document, I understand that:

- Accessibility to your Psychologist is limited to pre-scheduled appointment times.
- Certain situations including emergencies, crisis, and severe conditions may be inappropriate for psychiatric telemedicine services as your Psychologist is out of the area and not available on a daily or on call basis.
- Therefore, if I am suicidal, in crisis, or in an emergency, I should immediately call 9-1-1 or seek help from a hospital or crisis oriented health care facility in my areas.

Emergency situations include but are not limited to:

- Having thoughts about hurting or killing either another person or myself,
- Having hallucinations (seeing or hearing things that others don't),
- Having delusions (beliefs others may consider unrealistic),
- Being in a life threatening or emergency situation of any kind,
- Having uncontrollable emotion reactions,
- Being dysfunctional due to abusing drugs or alcohol
